

The fees required by Section 8-1 of the Aurora code of Ordinances (“Amusements”) shall be as follows:

1. Initial Application Fees:

- a. Video Gaming (Gambling) Distributor: two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
- b. Amusement Distributor: two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
- c. Pool Room: two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
- d. Arcade: two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
- e. Juice bar, dry cabaret, teenage cabaret or non-alcoholic bar: twenty five dollars (\$25.00).

2. Annual Licensing Fees:

- a. Video Gaming (Gambling) Distributor License: one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to distribute.
- b. Amusement Distributor License: one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to distribute.
- c. Pool Room License: six hundred dollars (\$600) (for 5 or more pool tables).
- d. Arcade License: six hundred dollars (\$600) (for eight (8) or more amusement devices, or combination of devices and pool tables).
- e. No annual licensing fee for operating less than eight (8) Amusements, or less than 5 Pool Tables. Annual operational fee required.
- f. No annual licensing fee for Electronic Musical Devices. Annual operational fee required.
- g. Shooting gallery, rifle range, gun club, or ax throwing club: fifty dollars per club/location (\$50).
- h. Juice bar, dry cabaret, teenage cabaret or non-alcoholic bar: six hundred dollars (\$600). No annual operational fee.

3. Operational fees:

- a. Distributor’s fee for Video Gaming (Gambling): one hundred dollars (\$100.00)/per machine/per month.
- b. Operator’s fee for Video Gaming (Gambling): twenty five dollars (\$25.00)/per machine/per month.
- c. Operator’s fee for Amusement Devices: fifty dollars (\$50) per device/per year.
- d. Operator’s fee for Pool Tables: one hundred dollars (\$100) per table/per year.
- e. Operator’s fee for Electronic musical devices: fifty dollars (\$50) per device/per year.
- f. Operator’s fee for shooting gallery, rifle range, gun club, or ax throwing club: \$365 per club/location/per year.

If the above fees are not paid by the applicable due date, then the annual licensing fees shall be doubled.

Licenses shall commence on October 1, and shall terminate on September 30, of the following year.

If a new license is applied for with six months or more of the current fee year remaining, the full annual licensing fees will be charged. If a new license is applied for with less than six months of the current fee year remaining, then only one half of the annual licensing fee will be charged.
