A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK
TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
FOX VALLEY PARK DISTRICT PERTAINING TO THE COOPERATIVE USE OF
STORM WATER DETENTION/RETENTION SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and Ill. Rev. Stat., 1989, Ch. 127, Paragraphs 741 to 749, provide authority for intergovernmental cooperation and intergovernmental agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora and the Fox Valley Park District have mutually agreed upon their respective responsibilities for storm water detention/retention systems located on Park District Property within the corporate limits of the City of Aurora.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Aurora, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois, hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (Attachment "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof) with the Fox Valley Park District pertaining


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to the cooperative use of storm water detenion/retention systems on Park District property located within the corporate limits of the City of Aurora.







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AGREEMENT BETWEEN FOX VALLEY PARK DISTRICT
AND THE CITY OF AURORA
RESPECT TO THE COOPERATIVE USE
OF STORM WATER DETENTION/RETENTION SYSTEMS

Agreement made this 19 day of MARCH,
1991, by and between the FOX VALLEY PARK DISTRICT, Kane,
DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois, a park district organized
and existing under the laws of Illinois (hereinafter referred
to as "PARK DISTRICT") and the CITY OF AURORA, an Illinois
municipal corporation, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois
(hereinafter referred to as "CITY");

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, PARK DISTRICT and CITY, as governmental units,
are authorized by the constitution and statutes of the State
of Illinois to enter into intergovernmental agreements; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire a cooperative relationship
between themselves and a definition of their respective
responsibilities with regard to storm sewer
retention/detention systems; and

WHEREAS, PARK DISTRICT and CITY are agreed that the
obligation to maintain, repair, renew, restore and replace
storm sewer drainage facilities on PARK DISTRICT lands is the
sole responsibility of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, PARK DISTRICT and CITY are agreed that the
obligation for recreational development, maintenance and use
of said PARK DISTRICT lands is the sole responsibility of the
PARK DISTRICT.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the following mutual
covenants and agreements, the parties agree as follows with
respect to all such PARK DISTRICT lands:

1. The CITY shall, at its own expense, undertake and be
responsible for the following:
 - A. The engineering and design of the storm water
system and any modifications or changes deemed
necessary for its intended function;
 - B. The maintaining, repairing, restoring,
renewing and replacing of all appurtenances
required for the proper and safe functioning
of such storm water detention systems,
including detention basins, retention lakes,
and storm sewers;

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- C. The drainage system for maintaining a dry bottom for detention basins;
 - D. The development and maintenance of all storm water control structures, storm sewers, sewer end sections, inlet structures, sheet piling, wing walls and necessary appurtenances to its operation of the storm water detention system;
 - E. The removal of silt deposits from retention lakes when such deposits interfere with the recreational use of the water body and/or is detrimental to aquatic life. The City shall complete the removal of silt deposits within a period of two years after the action is deemed necessary. The criteria for determining the need to remove silt deposits are as follows:
 - 1. When less than 25% of the lake has a minimum depth of 10 feet.
 - 2. When 25% or more of the side slope below water level is 6:1 or less.
 - F. The removal of excessive silt and debris and restoration of turf resulting from unusual flood conditions in detention basin;
 - G. The restoration of turf due to any failure of the storm sewer or underdrain system;
2. The PARK DISTRICT shall, at its own expense, undertake and be responsible for the following:
- A. The planning, design and engineering of all park recreation development on the site;
 - B. The care, development and maintenance of all vegetation, including turf, trees, and shrubs, being careful to not place trees or shrubs over tile, pipes and conduits;
 - C. The development and maintenance of all structures, equipment, and facilities for public recreational use;
 - D. Restoration of turf in detention basins destroyed or damaged by normal flood conditions;

E. Maintenance of the parks in a debris free and sightly condition, including debris accumulated on the exterior of the storm water inlet structures.

WHEREFORE, this Agreement has been executed the day and year first above written on behalf of the respective parties hereto by their duly authorized officers pursuant to ordinance or resolution lawfully adopted.
