	Incident Type	Definition	Examples
	○ Burglary from Motor Vehicle	The vehicle was entered for the purpose to commit a theft.	Items removed from the inside of a vehicle or the bed of a truck.
	○ Criminal Damage to Property	You believe your property was intentionally damaged.	Damage to home (e.g., damaged mailboxes/posts, broken windows, damaged yard decorations, etc.)
