We are providing a trolley that will run between venues and those lots. The website will also let attendees know of paid parking options at the Transportation Center and the Stolp Garages. I would like to use the City's lot on Water Street (the Permits building) for vendors and handicap parking, if possible. The current plan is to move vendors to the public lot or the Permits building lot after they unload their booths in the morning, then offer handicap parking in the other lot and along Water Street.
