Sec 2-125 Standing And Special Committee Operating Procedures

- (a) The chairperson of each special or standing committee shall preside at its meetings and prepare and submit all reports therefrom to the committee of the whole. A committee vice chairperson shall perform the duties of the committee chairperson in the chairperson's absence.
- (b) Each standing and special committee shall conduct its regular meetings at the times and in the locations designated by resolution of the council. A committee chairperson shall have the discretion to cancel regular meetings of the committee, and to convene a regular meeting at a time earlier or later than specified by council resolution to the extent authorized by the Open Meetings Act. A committee chairperson shall cancel any meeting of a standing committee when the sole item of business scheduled for consideration, apart from public comment required under paragraph (d) of this section, is the approval of the minutes of a previous meeting or meetings of the standing committee, except as required by law. Special committee meetings may be called by the committee chairperson, three (3) of the committee's members, or by the mayor in the manner authorized by law.
 - (c) Whenever the location of a standing or special committee meeting is insufficient to accommodate the public, the

- committee shall immediately adjourn to a more suitable location, providing due notice to the public present.
 - (d) Each standing or special committee may adopt rules permitting the public to address the committee during its meeting and shall include public comment as a regular order of business on all meeting agendas. In the absence of rules adopted by a committee, the rules adopted by the city council pertaining to public comment at its meetings shall govern. The Office of the Aldermen shall maintain copies of each committee's public comment rules and furnish them to the public upon oral or written request.
 - (e) All members of the council may participate in the deliberations of any standing or special committee in the same manner as any of its members, provided that only duly-appointed members of the committee may vote on matters before the committee. Each standing or special committee chairperson, in his or her discretion, may make materials available to the members of the committee as to any item or items of committee business available to any member of the council upon request.
 - (f) Each standing or special committee shall report to the committee of the whole on matters referred to the committee within thirty (30) days of the matter first appearing on the committee's agenda. A report of the committee shall briefly describe the matter, a summary of the committee's conclusions

- or findings, and a recommendation, motion, resolution,
