FOIA Final Briefing***

Project Background

The City of Aurora seeks to deploy a FOIA/Public Records Request solution that that complies with existing processes / rules and is also user friendly.

Following the Clearbox Process, Marketplace.city:

- Created a Market Landscape with 16 vendors
- Upon review of solution and experience, the stakeholders determine 10 fit COA criteria based on solution, experience and capabilities
- Vendor Questionnaire was sent to 10 companies to better understand capabilities, experience, implementation approach and pricing ([Opportunity Overview and Scope](#)) for interested vendors to read and complete in order to be included in the reporting and selection process
- *Project paused after reviewing initial data in March for COA COVID-19 response*
- Validated and analyzed Vendor Response (4 in all):
 - 3 companies responded by initial deadline of 2/25. Companies were GovQA, Granicus and Zylab /Armedia, a joint response sent by Zylab.
 - Incumbent (NextRequest) did not respond by deadline of 2/25;
 - Although response was received on 5/6, they were eliminated from the process
 - Aurora stakeholders reviewed solutions for 2 new companies – GovQA and Zylab(w/Armedia). Granicus only provided application layer and was not a complete solution. Team already familiar with NextRequest capabilities at the incumbent vendor.
- Based on stakeholder discussion, pricing for 5 years was asked of qualified companies in May for June 10th response.

Outreach was sent to 10 vendors, with 4 Vendor responses completed and reviewed in mandated timeline(2/25). Incumbent responded on 5/6 after being asked again for information.
