That Exhibit A to Legistar 19-0138 - May 7, 2019 Draft be amended by changing proposed Sec. 2-123(b) beginning on page 6, line 12, as follows:

Sec. 2-123. - Standing committees.

The mayor shall appoint the members of the standing (b) committees with the advice and consent of the city council. The mayor shall submit a complete set of committee appointments at the first meeting following the qualification of aldermen after each consolidated general election and at such other times as the mayor deems necessary, and the council shall vote for approval or disapproval of the committee appointments. In making appointments under this section, the mayor shall recommend the appointment of the mayor pro tem to the Rules, Administration, and Procedures Committee. In the event the mayor pro tem declines said appointment, the mayor shall recommend the alderman with the longest continuous service, other than the mayor pro tem, for appointment to said committee. If the council disapproves of the mayor's appointments, those voting to disapprove shall state their reasons, and the mayor shall submit a reconsidered set of appointments at the next regular council meeting. Until the council gives its advice and consent to the mayor's appointments following the qualification of aldermen, members previously appointed to the

standing committees under this section (b), or their successors, shall serve as members of the standing committees.
