Phase I Engineering for traffic signal modernization for the 8 signals from I-88 to Sheffer Rd, resurfacing from north of Molitor Rd to Creek Ave, a multi-use path from Illinois Prairie Path to Creek Ave, ADA ramp improvements, and associated work.

2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of three hundred seventy-one thousand three hundred forty-four and 00/100 Dollars (\$371,344.00) for the improvement of said section from the Local Public Agency's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds.
