Proposed 2023 Historic Preservation Grants Recommendations

We received 24 preservation grant applications requesting a total of \$333,510 in grant funding that would see \$527,967 of work being invested in the historic districts and landmarks.

The following are the projects the Historic Preservation Commission recommends for funding.

1.) 108 N View Street:

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is primary significant to the Tanner HD
- Scope: Porch Repair Replace tongue and groove flooring and replace front steps. Flooring is deteriorated and missing in places.
- Total Project Cost: \$5,024
- Maximum Grant Amount: \$5,024

2.) 215 Grand Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a contributing to the Tanner HD
- Scope: Repair and Paint Siding & Repair Windows Replace rotted wood and scrape, prime and paint all peeling wood. Replace windowsills, repair window trim, and repair glazing.
- Total Project Cost: \$8,184
- Maximum Grant Amount: \$8,184

3.) 219 West Park Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource to Tanner HD
- Scope: Porch Restoration Replace porch, steps, and handrail and rebuild knee wall.
- Total Project Cost: \$24,420
- Maximum Grant Amount: \$18,210

4.) 329 S. Lincoln Avenue

- Overview: single-family home that is contributing to Near Eastside HD
- Scope: Porch Restoration Restore front porch only. Work must include rebuilding the front porch
 to more accurately resemble a historic porch that is appropriate to the style. Work can include
 replacing newel posts to properly align and replacing treads, risers, handrail, bottom rail, and
 spindles.
- Total Project Cost: \$31,958
- Maximum Grant Amount: \$21,000

5.) 333 Lawndale Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family that is a primary recourse to Riddle Highlands HD
- Scope: Painting Power Wash, sand, caulk, and paint trim, windows, porch, railings and gutters.
- Total Project Cost: \$7,315
- Maximum Grant Amount: \$7,315

6.) 353-355 West Park Avenue

• Overview: Owner-occupied, two-unit home that is contributing to the Tanner HD

- Scope: Siding Repair, Porch Repair, & Painting- Replace cedar boards, replace stairs, scrape and paint. Work can also include repairing or replacing railings, balusters, lattice, window trim, and doors.
- Total Project Cost: \$8,000

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$8,000

7.) 417 Spruce Street

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a contributing to Tanner HD
- Scope: Bay Window Restoration Work includes repairing the bay window in a manner that will
 address the structural issues in a long-term manner. This could include, but not be limited to,
 mudjacking, excavating and pouring a proper footing with a new concrete stem wall on top, or
 other possible determination suggested by contractors.
- Total Project Cost: \$23,142

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$17,571

8.) 424 West Park Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource for Tanner HD
- Scope: Window & Door Restoration, Custom Wood Storms- Restore 21 windows and 2 doors, including removing paint, repairing wood, sanding, priming and painting sash, jamb, and sill. Reglaze glass opening with existing glass.
- Total Project Cost: \$34,650

Maximum Grant Amount: \$21,000

9.) 426 Palace Street

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource to Tanner HD
- Scope: Half-Round Gutter Replacement Replace gutters with 6 inch half-round aluminum gutters and replace downspouts with round downspout.
- Total Project Cost: \$11,454.30

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$11,454

10.) 452 Pennsylvania Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is contributing to the Tanner HD
- Scope: Desiding Remove vinyl siding and install engineered wood siding, factory painted with 3 1/2 in reveal. Contractor showed staff photos of additional areas with no original siding underneath.
- Total Project Cost: \$19,831

Maximum Grant Amount: \$15,916

11.)506 W. Downer Place

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is within the Westside HD
- Scope: Soffit and Eave Restoration Replace deteriorated molded soffits and eaves in kind. Restore gutter lining. House would have to become a Local Landmark.
- Total Project Cost: \$12,375

Maximum Grant Amount: \$12,187

12.)518 W. Downer Place

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a Local Landmark
- Scope: Side Entrance Construction Work includes adding a new wood deck with stairs and railings on the side of the house. Work must be designed to be historic and coherent with the front porch.

• Total Project Cost: \$20,890

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$17,000

13.)535 W Downer Place

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a Local Landmark
- Scope: Porch Restoration, Siding Repair, Window Repair, New Wood Storms Have 15-17 custom
 wood storms made matching the existing wood storms. Repair 4 windows in the turret. Replace
 porch decking, repair rails and balusters, replace some rails and balusters, add handrail to steps.
 Repair siding.

• Total project Cost: \$43,703

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$21,000

14.)619 Palace Street

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource in Palace St HD
- Scope: Painting Replace areas on fascia and soffits. Power wash, scrape, spot prime, and paint with two coats soffits, fascia, trim, siding and doors.

• Total Project Cost: \$9,394

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$9,394

15.) 625 Oak Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource for Tanner HD
- Scope: Window Restoration & Siding Repair & Painting 18 windows will be stripped, sanded stained and varnished to match the existing original. Window glass will be re-glazed and damaged glass will be replaced. New metal sash chains will be supplied. Strip paint to bare wood and repaint in three part color scheme.

Total Project Cost: \$53,416

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$18,000

16.)737 Pennsylvania Avenue

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource to Riddle Highlands HD
- Scope: Painting Repair, scrape, caulk, prime and paint wood siding, fascia, soffits, door, window frames.

Total Project Cost: \$8,415

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$8,415

17.)816 Palace Street

- Overview: Owner-occupied, single-family home that is a primary resource to Riddle Highlands HD
- Scope: Front Entrance Repair Remove the entire stonework, repair the concrete as needed, reset the stone, replace the damaged stone with new to match the existing and reset the railing as needed.

• Total Project Cost: \$6,490

• Maximum Grant Amount: \$6,490
