
DOWNTOWN AURORA: SPECIAL SERVICE AREA ONE

CURRENT SPECIAL SERVICE AREA ONE (SSA1) BOUNDARY MAP



-The current SSA1 assessment rate on properties within these boundaries is approximately 1%

-SSA1 established in 1979, **expires in calendar year 2026**

THE LIFECYCLE OF SSA1 FUNDS



1 - Property Owners Pay In



2 – City of Aurora Manages the Fund



3 – Disbursement Through Agreement



4 – Funds Support Special Services

IMPORTANT NOTE ON FUND OWNERSHIP & USE

-SSA1 funds are separate from the City of Aurora's general fund

- -These funds **belong to SSA1 stakeholders** (i.e. the property owners who pay into the fund)
- -The **sole purpose** of SSA1 funds is to support **special services** within the **SSA1 boundaries**
- -The **City's role** is strictly to manage, safeguard, and ensure proper allocation of the funds in alignment with the agreed-upon services

BACKGROUND OF AURORA DOWNTOWN

- -Aurora Downtown was a not-for-profit corporation made up of local commercial property owners within SSA1
- -It was contracted by the **City of Aurora** to provide **special services** within the SSA1 district
- -It helped revitalize downtown through events like **First Fridays** and **Holiday Window Decorating**, and by providing resources such as **business grants** and more

AURORA DOWNTOWN: RECENT HISTORY

- -Lawsuits and leadership changes resulted in the organization being dissolved 2024-2025
- -The Aurora Regional Economic Alliance assumed First Friday event responsibilities **through December 2025**

Request **SSA1 funds** to cover **legal, accounting, & consulting services** (prep bylaws, governance policies, and tax-exempt applications)

Work with interim leadership council to select vendors

City staff will provide support to assist with logistics, coordination, and oversight

Build consensus of draft bylaws with SSA1 members
