RESOLUTION NO. R21-229
DATE OF PASSAGE August 24, 2021

A Resolution authorizing Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment 2021-#2 to reallocate prior year resources and current year resources in response to the Corona Virus pandemic and other eligible activities.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, housing activities through funding by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan which have been adopted by the City Council and which have defined priorities for CDBG, HOME, and ESG funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora's Block Grant Working Committee recommended adoption of Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment 2021-#2 to reflect CDBG-CV funding reallocations at its August 4, 2021 meeting; and

WHEREAS, CDBG-CV funding will be available in the 2021 City Budget CDBG-CV program account (214-1330-801-46-series); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, finds as facts all of the preamble recitals of this Resolution and hereby approves a Resolution authorizing approval of the Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment (2021-#2) and authorizes the City's Mayor, Chief Community Services Officer, Community Development Manager, or their designees to execute any contracts as well as any other documents associated with these approvals, including but not limited to HUD's program administration requirements.
