- 1 Sec. 27-176. Parking commercial vehicles, trailers, truck tractors in residencetial districts.
- 2 No commercial vehicle, trailer or truck tractor exceeding two (2) tons in weight, according to vehicle
- 3 registration classification, shall be permitted to be parked on any public street in a residence district for a
- 4 longer period than two (2) hours. Vehicles that violate this section for six (6) or more consecutive hours
- 5 shall be subject to towing by order of the police department.

- No commercial vehicle or truck tractor, with or without a trailer, exceeding two (2) tons in weight, according to vehicle registration, or any type of trailer, regardless of the trailer or semi-trailer is attached to another vehicle shall be permitted to park on any public street in a residential district:
  - (a) is prohibited from parking between the hours of 10 p.m. to 7 a.m; or
  - (b) for a period longer than two hours between the hours of 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.; or
- (c) in a manner to obstruct other vehicular traffic or cause a hazard.
- 14 For the purposes of this section, trailer is defined as: Every vehicle without motive power in operation,
- designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor vehicle and so constructed that
- 16 no part of its weight rests upon the towing vehicle including but not limited to travel trailers, watercraft
- trailers, utility trailers, travel trailers, truck campers, camping trailers, and vehicle transport trailers.
- 18 Vehicles in violation of this section shall be subject to towing by order of the police department.
