

1 Sec. 27-176. - Parking commercial vehicles, trailers, truck tractors in residential districts.

2 ~~No commercial vehicle, trailer or truck tractor exceeding two (2) tons in weight, according to vehicle~~  
3 ~~registration classification, shall be permitted to be parked on any public street in a residence district for a~~  
4 ~~longer period than two (2) hours. Vehicles that violate this section for six (6) or more consecutive hours~~  
5 ~~shall be subject to towing by order of the police department.~~

8 No commercial vehicle or truck tractor, with or without a trailer, exceeding two (2) tons in weight,  
9 according to vehicle registration, or any type of trailer, regardless of the trailer or semi-trailer is attached  
10 to another vehicle shall be permitted to park on any public street in a residential district:

11 (a) is prohibited from parking between the hours of 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.; or

12 (b) for a period longer than two hours between the hours of 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.; or

13 (c) in a manner to obstruct other vehicular traffic or cause a hazard.

14 For the purposes of this section, trailer is defined as: Every vehicle without motive power in operation,  
15 designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor vehicle and so constructed that  
16 no part of its weight rests upon the towing vehicle including but not limited to travel trailers, watercraft  
17 trailers, utility trailers, travel trailers, truck campers, camping trailers, and vehicle transport trailers.

18 Vehicles in violation of this section shall be subject to towing by order of the police department.
