SUBJECT: Treasurer's Report – December 2025

Attached for your information is the Treasurer's Report for the month ended December 31, 2025. Please note that this is a cash-basis report.

Included below are the ending balances as of December 31, 2025, for both fund and cash balances. Of these two amounts, cash balance is the more meaningful metric since this represents liquid cash and/or invested assets which can be used (or easily sold) to support and fund current operations. While ending fund balance is also an important measurement of the City's financial health, it usually includes illiquid assets or future cash receipts or disbursements such as receivables (including property tax) due to the City and accounts payable/accrued expenses. The enterprise funds' fund balances reflect net short-term assets and liabilities, to more accurately present resources available to finance current operations.

The fund balances included in this financial report are based on preliminary unaudited 2025 year-end balances. Additional closing entries to 2025 activity are still being processed and balances may change as a result of the audit process. The audit fieldwork is scheduled to take place in March with the final reports being issued by June 30, 2026.

As of December 31, 2025, the General Fund is reporting a net surplus of \$4,976,159.66. The General Fund balance is \$29,578,477.80 with a cash balance of \$42,439,138.46. The attached supplemental chart shows the General Fund revenues are 93% and expenses are 90% of the annual budget.

Through December 31, 2025, the HOME Program Grant Fund shows a fund balance of negative \$56,340.96 and a negative cash balance of \$64,326.31. This is due to the timing of grant funding revenues that are funded on a reimbursement basis.

Through December 31, 2025, the Block Grant Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$183,498.19 and a negative cash balance of \$350,498.19. This is due to the timing of grant funding revenues that are funded on a reimbursement basis.

Through December 31, 2025, the Section 108 Loan Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$233,647.18 and a negative cash balance of \$299,397.14. This is due to the timing of payments made and revenues received.

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #10 Galena/Broadway Fund shows a fund balance of \$86,453.29 and a negative cash balance of \$57,761.29. This is due to the timing of payments made with redevelopment agreements and TIF funds received. Short term lines of credit are treated differently than long term bonds and the deficit balance will be addressed when the lines of credit are paid in the near future through developer payments or long-term bond issuance

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #11 Benton/River Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$7,242.29 and a negative cash balance of \$7,242.29. This is due to the timing of payments made with redevelopment agreements and TIF funds received. Short term lines of credit are treated differently than long term bonds and the deficit balance will be addressed when the lines of credit are paid in the near future through developer payments or long-term bond issuance

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #13 River/Galena Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$1,490,248.32 and a negative cash balance of \$1,472,206.40. This is due to the timing of payments made with redevelopment agreements and TIF funds received. Short term lines of credit are treated differently than long term bonds and the deficit balance will be addressed when the lines of credit are paid in the near future through developer payments or long-term bond issuance.

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #14 Lincoln/Westin fund shows a negative fund balance of \$4,478,201.07 and a negative cash balance of \$4,478,201.07. This is due to the timing of payments made with redevelopment agreements and TIF funds received. Short term lines of credit are treated differently than long term bonds and the deficit balance will be addressed when the lines of credit are paid in the near future through developer payments or long-term bond issuance.

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #18 DAC fund shows a negative fund balance of \$11,936,391.03 and a negative cash balance of \$11,623,391.03. The City's financial contributions for the DAC Development were paid during late 2024 and 1Q2025. The negative cash balance will be cleared by funds transfers in future months. Any amounts advanced by other funds will be tracked so that any advances can be reimbursed by future TIF revenues to the extent they are available to do so.

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #19 110 Cross Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$354,043.71 and a negative cash balance of \$354,043.71. This is due to the timing of payments made with redevelopment agreements and TIF funds received.

Through December 31, 2025, the TIF #20 River Vine Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$14,826.32 and a negative cash balance of \$14,826.32. This is due to the timing of payments made with redevelopment agreements and TIF Funds received.


Through December 31, 2025, the fund Property & Casualty Insurance shows a negative fund balance of \$1,201,655.89 and a cash balance of \$8,145,751.72. This is due to timing of payments made and revenues received.

Through December 31, 2025, the fund Employee Compensated Absences Benefits Fund shows a negative fund balance of \$1,330,048.59 and a cash balance of \$20,442,258.02. This is due to timing of payments made and revenues received.


