**Additional Comments or Instructions:**

At the time of inspection, the owner was advised that in the absence of manufacturers' requirements to the contrary, the following minimum safety requirements apply:

- [1] 14) All anchor tabs must be used each time the attraction is inflated.
- [1] Each tab, attachment and anchor must be in good condition and resist a pull of at least 75 lb. for inflatable bounces and 500 lbs. for inflatable slides unless the manufacturer's specification is more. The use of cotton rope, tarp straps, Bungee cords or elastic straps is prohibited.
- [1] 16) Motor vehicles may not be used at anchors.
- [1] 17) The attraction must never be inflated or operated in winds over 25 mph.
- [1] 18) A trained attendant must be at the attraction at all times.
