Sec 2-521 Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander Advisory Board

- 1. Creation and Purpose. The Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander Advisory Board is hereby created for encouraging the education and preservation of Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander culture and history, the empowerment and upliftment of the Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander community through advocacy, education, and engagement, to serve as a bridge between the Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander community and all other communities within the City, and to encourage civil engagement within the Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander Community.
- 2. Powers and Duties. The Board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the city and in connection therewith shall:
 - 1. Organize or promote events recognizing Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander Heritage.
 - 2. Encourage the education, advocacy, and community involvement of the City's Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander youth.
 - 3. Help promote a greater awareness and ongoing cross-cultural understanding.
 - 4. To build higher levels of civic engagement between local government entities and the Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander Community.
 - 5. To encourage or help provide opportunities for our current Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander residents and businesses.
 - 6. To embrace the Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander community through Board's/City's cultural and Socio-economic outreach efforts.
 - 7. Help raise funds and/or promote scholarship to financially assist Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander college-bound high school seniors.
- 3. Membership. The Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander Advisory Board shall consist of thirteen (13) members.
