

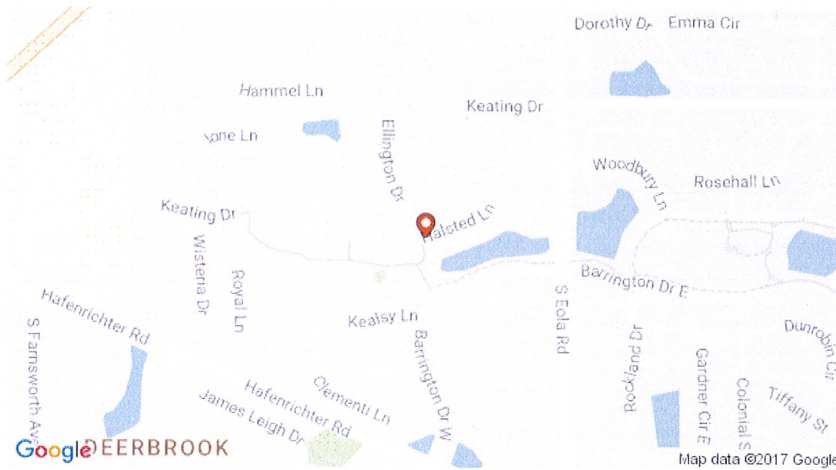

Alderman Bugg,

I hope you have enjoyed your weekend! As you can see from my post yesterday our street is very concerned about the volume of speeders that pass on Ellington Drive. Everyday we witness at least one person speeding over 40 mph on Ellington Drive. With the number of children that live on or around Ellington Drive (over 20) and the number of children that are constantly crossing the street we are concerned that one of our children in the neighborhood will be struck by a speeding vehicle. Yesterday we had a younger gentlemen in a grey scion drive down our street at over 60 mph seconds after 6 children crossed the street. Our video camera caught the drivers vehicle at 5:33PM. As he passed our house and approached the park on Barrington and Ellington he almost hit a neighbor who was walking her dogs. The police officer that came to the house encouraged us to work with you to provide a permanent solution as well as to go to the city council meetings until our concerns are heard and addressed.

Again this is not a single occurrence as several neighbors are constantly yelling at vehicles that are speeding down the road where children are playing. During traffic times many commuters use Ellington to avoid construction and traffic on Eola. In many cases they are easily exceeding 40 mph. I understand that neighbors have worked with previous alderman with no success as their wasn't sufficient traffic at the time (this was 6 years ago or more). With the boom in construction over the years and the widening of Eola we are feeling the

excess traffic on Ellington and it is becoming very dangerous for us in front of our own homes and equally important near the park.

We have multiple families with little children from new borns to teenagers on our street and on Halsted and I can easily count over 45 children within a small radius of my house. I do not want to be emailing you or the city after an accident or a death from reckless driving on our residential street over something that we can fix by working together.

Please let me know what I need to do with my neighbors on Ellington and Halsted to make this happen. WE are willing to meet with you and any other officials as well as to provide a signed petition from the neighborhood to have these safety improvements added for the safety of our children.
