Thank you for your prompt attention. We appreciate the consideration you have given the Gates Elementary Community. We are working hard to be a good neighbor by creating traffic patterns that do not inconvenience the residents of the area and promote safe passage for the students and parents. There are currently No Parking signs on the east side of Gates St. between Simms and 7th Ave., however the No Parking hours are 7:00 a.m. -10:00 a.m. It would be beneficial to have the Parking ban during school hours 7:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. By doing this, a wider path of travel is created. When parking is allowed, the street becomes one way, and the roadway becomes congested. We have worked hard this year communicating with our neighbors by walking door to door and passing out flyers to create a partnership with them. Our hope is to decrease congestion so that all parties, school community and neighbors, can move fluidly through the area.
