

## Emergency Plan For Cock A Doodle Brew Fest 2018

While we anticipate no real issues at Cock A Doodle Brew Fest (known as CDB from herein), we still want to prepare for any unforeseen incidents. This document will serve as an outline of our plans to keep our patrons safe, and ensure we have the proper precautions in place.

The first area we want to cover is emergency access for fire/ambulance during the festival. The festival will be completely fenced, and we will keep the drive way on the south side of the festival outside of the fenced area, assuring it stays open for emergency vehicle traffic. This is the lane that runs from the street into the rotunda for the Hollywood Casino. We will keep a turnaround lane open as well so the vehicles will have plenty of room to make a u turn and exit the same lane they drove in on. This allows the vehicles free pass from foot traffic, and will not have to drive through areas where there will be attendees. While we do not plan on having an ambulance on site, we feel this plan will allow us access to one should the need arise.

Safety of our attendees is our paramount concern. Based on a current estimated audience size of 800 people, we will have 2 Aurora police officers on site from the moment the festival opens, through one hour after close (11a-6 PM). My director of operations and his team will both liaison with the police officers and follow any and all directions given by the police during the course of the event.

While this is a rain or shine event, we will clear the festival grounds if we see lightning strikes from our vantage point. Also, any severe or tornado weather warnings issued in the immediate area will cause us to suspend the festival. We will encourage fest goers to head into the Casino, or to their cars for shelter. We will use social media and our 5 radio stations to announce when it is safe to reenter the grounds.

If there is an emergency evacuation needed, we will have our crowd management certified personal take over, 1 will head to the stage for announcements and the others will fan out to each of the emergency exits. Again, when the coast is clear we will announce it on the radio and our social media channels.

Our floor plan has adequate room for emergency and traditional exists for safe vacating of the premises. Our main entrance will stay open at all times, and will measure 23 feet wide. We plan to have 3 other emergency exists established, each measuring 23 feet wid.

We are working hard to ensure that we hide our water and electric cabling, restricting them to areas where there is no foot traffic. In the event we do need to run a line, we will use a safety ramp to wrap the cables into.

We continue to partner with Lou Doug Entertainment to assist in this event. He is a professional promoter with a spotless reputation in the region, producing over 25 events a year. He will have a staff on hand to ensure our volunteers are educated on their respective duties.
