**RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING MOTOR FUEL TAX FUNDS TO PAY CITY OF AURORA'S
SHARE OF ROUTE 59 IMPROVEMENTS PER AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
WITH THE STATE OF ILLINOIS/DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 authorizes units of local government to cooperate with each other in order to accomplish common goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 200/1 et seq., provides that any power or powers, privilege or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a public agency may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any other public agencies and private enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Illinois/Department of Transportation for various improvements of IL Route 59 from approximately 1600 feet south of North Aurora Road to 800 feet south of Aurora Avenue/New York Street known as FAP Route 338, State Section (112 & 113) WRS-7; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the aforementioned Agreement, it is necessary for the City to appropriate sufficient Motor Fuel Tax Funds to pay its share of the costs for said improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that, pursuant to the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A", there is hereby appropriated by the City of Aurora the sum of Two Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Six Hundred Twenty dollars (\$239,620.00) of Motor Fuel Tax Funds, or so much thereof as is necessary, to pay its share of the cost of the improvements as provided in said Agreement, and the City Clerk being authorized hereby to sign the IDOT Resolution therefore; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon award of the contract for the improvements to Route 59, the City will pay to the State in a lump sum an amount equal to 80% of its obligation incurred pursuant to said Agreement, and will thereafter pay to the State the remainder of the obligation in a lump sum, upon completion of the project, based on final approved costs.
