Natalie Wiza, Coordinator of Emergency Management - City of Aurora provided an outline of the City of Aurora Emergency Management's preparedness for the reception of passengers on busses arriving from the State of Texas and the process for the passengers to be properly cared for and to insure the safe passage of these individuals to their final destinations and entitled services in the City of Chicago.

Nydia Molina, Assistant Corporation Counsel - City of Aurora provided information regarding the proposed ordinance.

Members of the City Council posed questions to those City staff members who presented on this item as well as Corporation Counsel Veenstra.
