

Project Description:

Zion Nuclear Power Station was the third dual-reactor nuclear power plant in the Commonwealth Edison (ComEd) network and served Chicago and the northern quarter of Illinois. The plant was built in 1973 and houses two 1,100 megawatt pressurized water reactors. The facility is located on 257 acres of Lake Michigan shoreline, in the city of Zion, IL.

The Zion Nuclear Power Station was retired in 1998. On August 23, 2010, it was announced that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission approved the transfer of Exelon's (ComEd's parent company) license to Energy Solutions (ES) of Salt Lake City. The company will dismantle the site over a ten year period

Energy Solutions awarded EHC a lump sum contract to complete the abatement of asbestos from all site structures including the Turbine Bldg., Fuel Handling Bldg., and Unit 1&2 Containments.

The ability to provide an integrated service offering and meet an aggressive time schedule was key to being awarded the contract. As an integral component of the overall ES D&D Project, the work scope also includes scaffold installation, containment erection, waste packaging and manifesting, and air sampling and analysis. Simultaneous work on multiple elevations requiring in excess of 50 workers and support staff per shift.






