

1 **Sec. 2-469 Aging-in-Community Advisory Board**

2 (a) The Aging-in-Community Advisory Board is established to
3 promote and enhance the quality of life and resident
4 involvement for residents ages 62 and above, in order to
5 amplify Aurora's commitment to Aging-in-Community.

6 (b) The advisory board duties are advisory and include:

7 1. Solicit input and act as a public forum for issues that
8 affect persons ages 62 and above in the City by hosting
9 public meetings, obtaining factual data and provide this
10 information to the City Council with recommendations.

11 2. Identify and work with and support existing senior
12 programs and provide a seamless network of services that
13 meets the needs of persons ages 62 and over in the City
14 of Aurora.

15 3. Assist with the creation of services for seniors,
16 programs, and events available for Aurora residents ages
17 62 and above.

18 4. Assist with volunteer recruitment for programs and
19 services for persons ages 62 and above.

20 5. Provide insight into the Aging-in-Community and Age-
21 Friendly initiatives for the City of Aurora.

22 (c) Membership. The Aging-in-Community Advisory Board shall
23 consist of nine (9) members.

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
