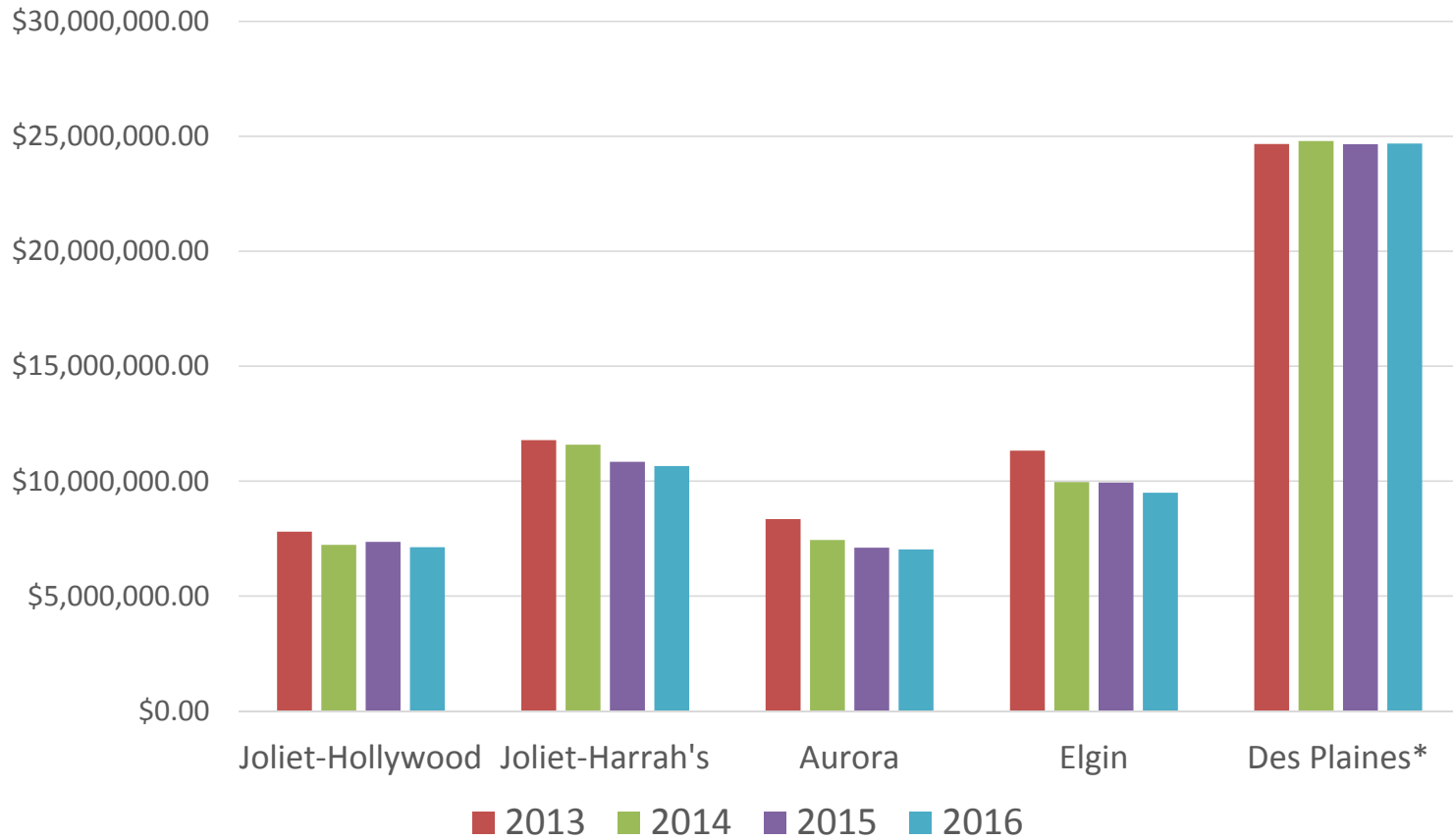

# Chicagoland Casinos 2013-2016

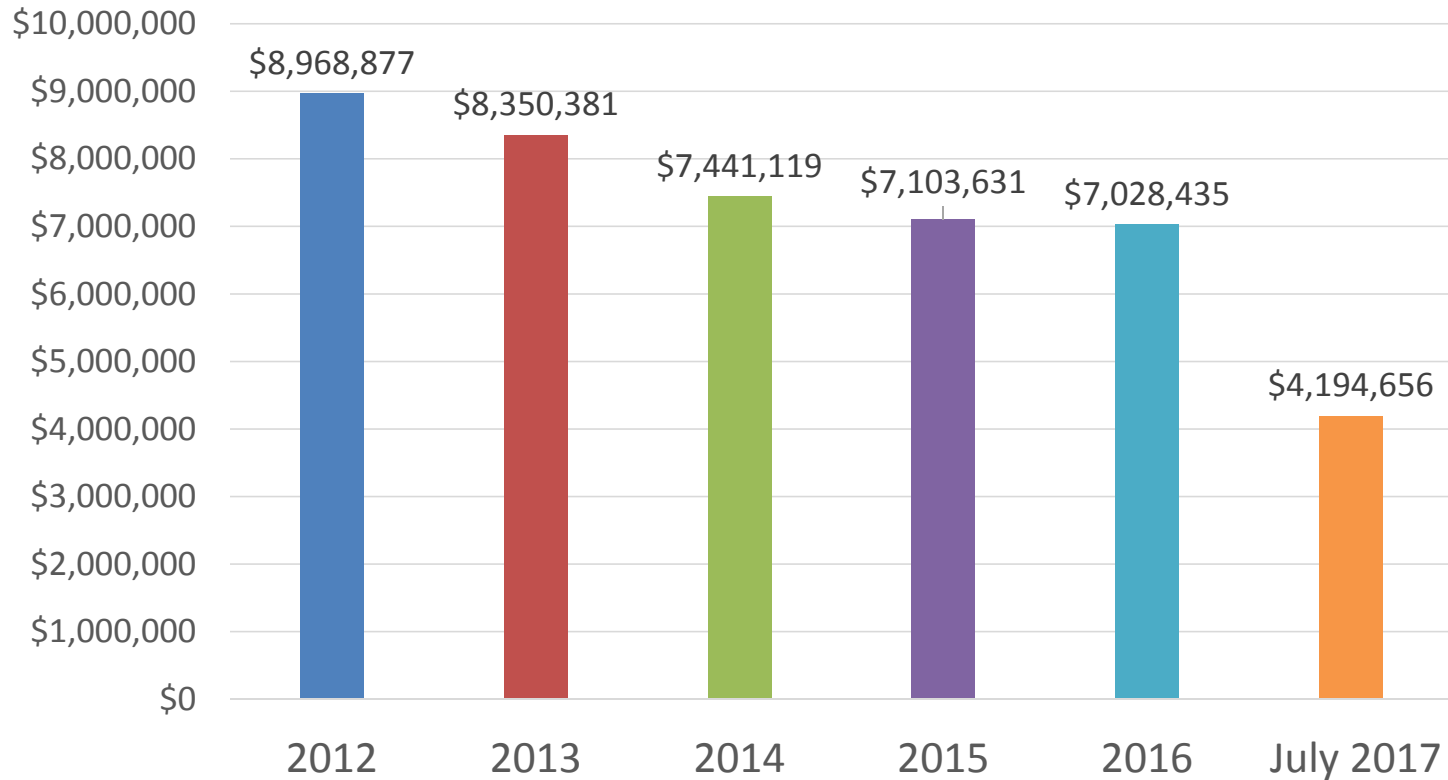

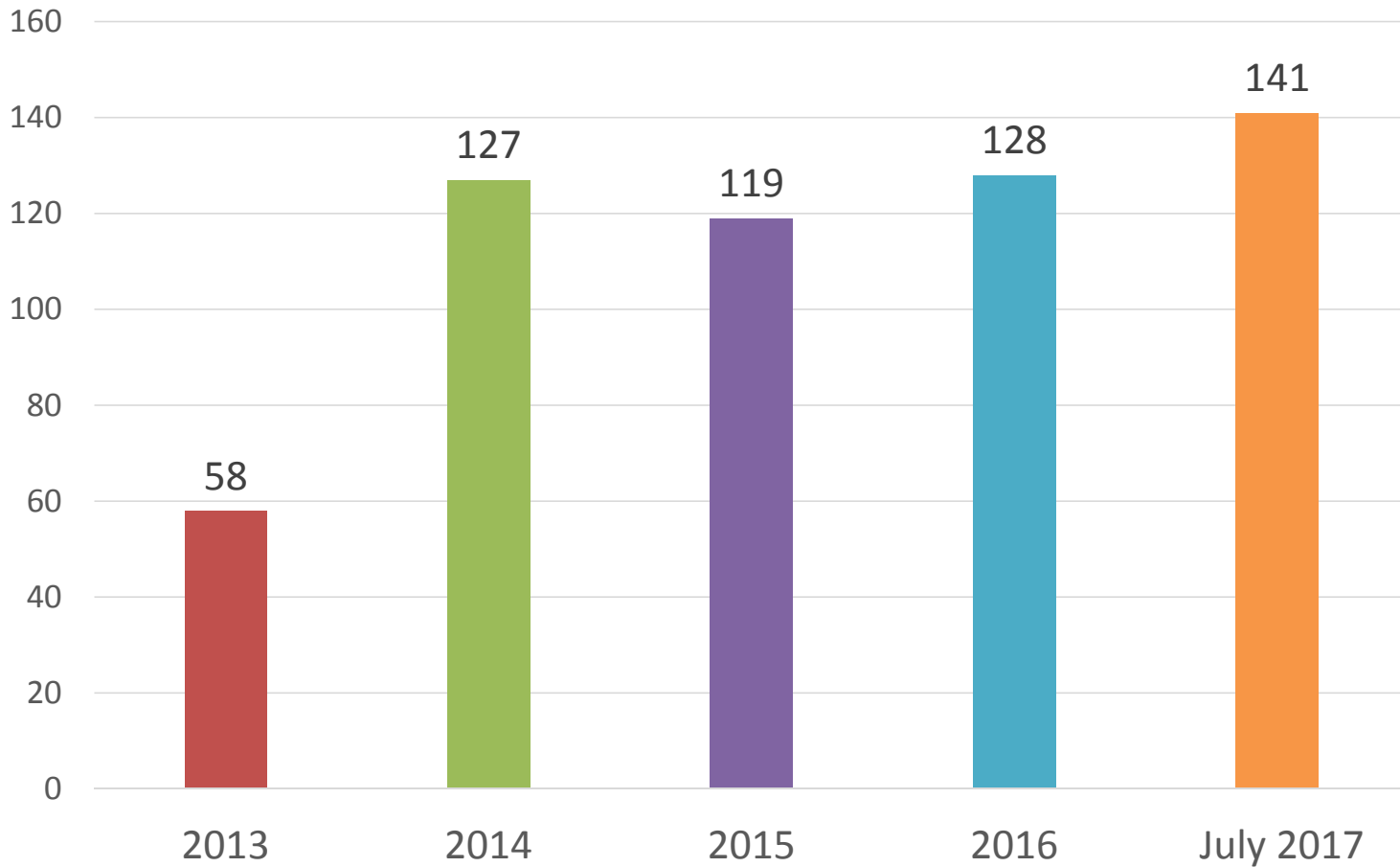
# Casino Revenue

## Hollywood Casino Aurora





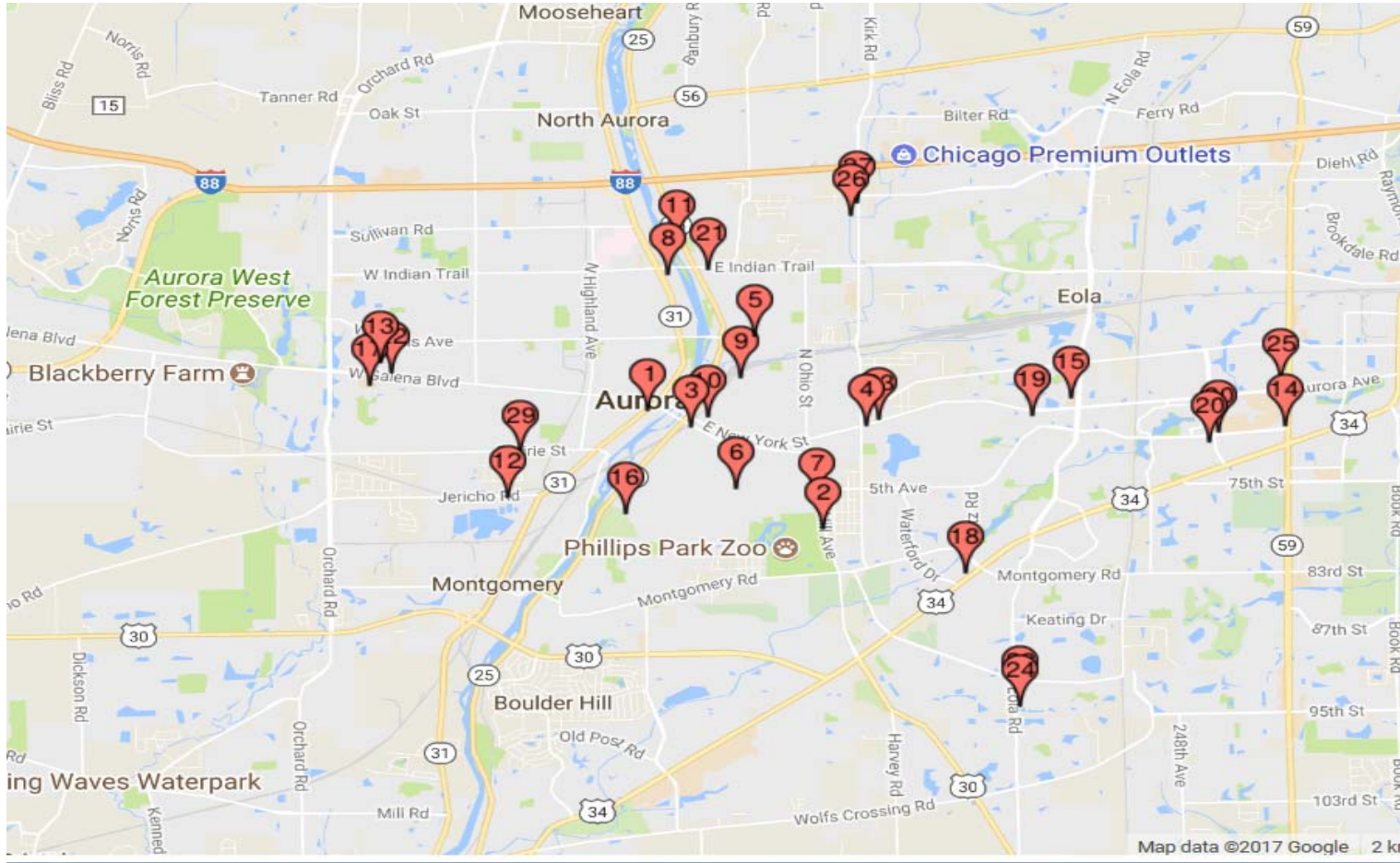
## Aurora Video Gaming Terminal Growth since 2013

## VGT Regulations Utilized in Other Illinois Municipalities

- Cap the maximum number of video gaming terminals (VGT) licensed citywide
- Cap maximum number of VGT per site
- Implement geographic limitations and/or bans
- Place time frames for businesses before can apply for terminal license
- Increase terminal fees
