- Solicit only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- Permit is valid for up to one (1) year from date of issue
- If there is a "No Soliciting" sign posted, it is against city ordinance to solicit at that home or business
- Leave a residence as soon as you are asked without question.
- Do not place any flyers, pamphlets, leaflets, etc. in mailboxes.
- All persons engaging in such charitable solicitation shall have a copy of the permit on their person at all times during any such solicitation.
- You do not represent the City of Aurora, and we are not endorsing your product. Attempting to mislead the public in any way may result in a citation or revocation of your permit.
- Such charitable solicitation shall be confined to house-to-house canvassing and/or solicitation
  in the public ways or places of the city, and shall not be conducted upon highways, streets, alleys and vehicular thoroughfares of the city. (See Sec. 32-3 (b) (1-3) attached.)

The undersigned hereby makes application for a Peddler/Solicitor Permit in the City of Aurora, IL, pursuant to Chapter 32 of the Municipal Code of Aurora, IL.

By signing this registration form, I am stipulating that no individual employees, independent contractors, employees of independent contractors, volunteers or any other such person associated with the registrant is a "Sex Offender" as described by the State of Illinois Statute 730 ILCS 150/2 and as may similarly be applicable to and by other law enforcement jurisdictions throughout the United States and I certify that such persons listed on this application, including registrant, have not been convicted of any felony, nor convicted on two (2) or more occasions of driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
