In addition, strategic media collaborations, developing and establishing prudent marketing partnerships allow for events to be held at **The Bunkers** facility to aid in the visibility of the company and the Aurora Municipal Airport, itself. These events can consist of, although are not limited to, holding annual or semi-annual aircraft ride days, participating in the Experimental Aircraft Associations' Young Eagles program, hosting the International Aerobatic Clubs' competitions, and more.

Furthermore, **The Bunker** can aid in supporting various flight contracts for local flight schools by offering training that is not traditionally available by their own means, as well as the Department of Defense, Federal Bureau of Investigation, and other Government and Military entities.

The Bunker can also support various opportunities that are, again, not limited to air-to-air photography and videography, event flyovers, flight test support, ground seminars, advertised aircraft rides to the public meeting the Federal Aviation Regulation 119.1 requirements, as well as aid customers that are in a position to acquire their own aircraft by providing professional consultation and insight.
