Suppliers: MC2 Energy

End Date: Program ends with December 2025 meter reads

Program Highlights

- Civic Contribution to Aurora \$103,200 per year.
- Program matched the ComEd Rate "No Rate Risk"
- Residents could leave the program at anytime with zero cancellation fees.
- Residents continue to receive one invoice from ComEd
- Residents may continue to choose a different 3rd party supplier at any time.
