Categories of Business Authorized for Consideration on the Consent Agenda of the City Council Without Prior Consideration by the Standing Committees or the Committee of the Whole.

1. **Council Meeting Minutes.** Approval of the minutes of any regular or special meeting of the City Council;
2. **Matters Involving "Dormant" Special Service Areas.** Ordinances proposing the establishment of special service areas, calling for public hearings there upon, and establishing special service areas when a) establishment is required by the Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance as adopted by the City and b) the owner or owners of the real property subject to the special service area or the contract purchaser of such real property has given written consent to the establishment of the special service area;
3. **Acceptance of Public Improvements and Maintenance Securities.** Matter authorizing the acceptance of public improvements and the maintenance security thereupon as provided by the Chapter 43 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Aurora ("City Code");
4. **Reduction or Waiver of Maintenance Securities.** Matters authorizing the reduction or waiver of maintenance securities in favor of the City required by Chapter 43 of the City Code or any other provision of the City Code;
5. **Dedications, Easements, Vacations of Real Property.** Matters authorizing the acceptance or approval of the dedication of any interest in real property in favor of the City, including, but not limited to, rights-of-way, easements. Matters involving the vacation or abandonment of all or part of the City's interest in real property when consistent with a policy approved by the City Council to divest such interest for nominal consideration. Matters authorizing the approval of plats reflecting the transfer of interests in real property described hereunder.

All matters eligible for consideration pursuant to Sec. 2-101(a) of the City Code shall be denoted as "Direct to Council Consent" on the agendas of the City Council.
