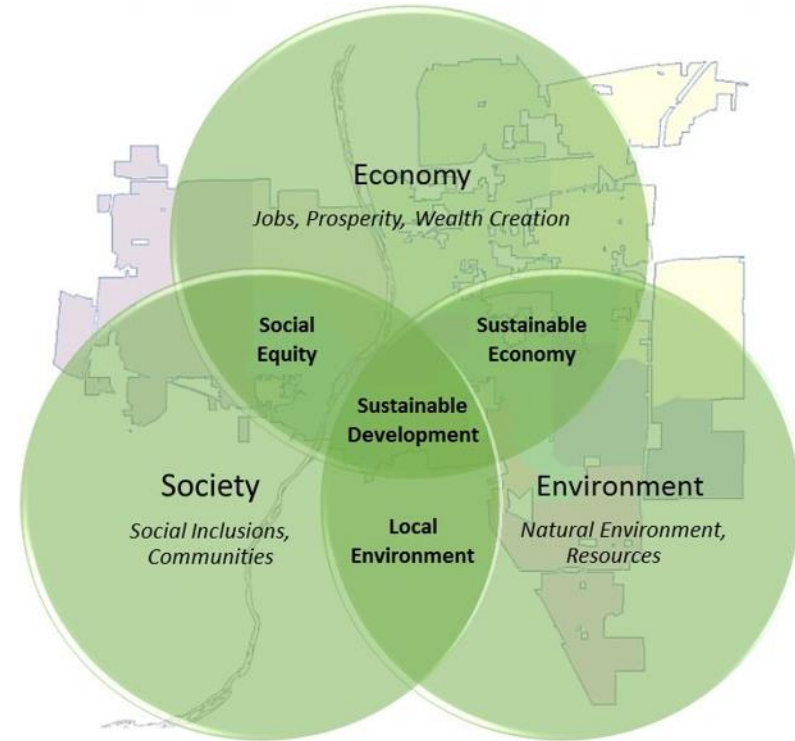

Introduction



History

- The City of Aurora approved its first Sustainability Plan in 2009.
- A Sustainable Aurora Advisory Board was created in 2014.
- The first task the board decided to undertake was to create an updated sustainability plan to address ongoing issues, concerns and opportunities.





Proposed Changes

Major Changes in the Plan

- Simplified the plan while adding sections missing in the original plan
- Three additional focus areas were added: Climate, Resilient Community, and Environmental Justice
- The plan moved from being task oriented to strategic
- Greater interconnection to Chicago Metropolitan Region while maintaining a clear Aurora perspective



Framework

- The sustainability plan update of 2016, was restructure using the Greenest Region Compact 2 from the Metropolitan Mayor's Caucus as a template.
- The Board also shifted from a task oriented perspective in the first plan to a more strategic focus.
- The updated plan is easier to understand and track over time.

- The Sustainable Aurora Advisory Board offers suggestions and assistance to the City in transforming the plan into reality.
- The plan is well-suited to working with other cities in Illinois and abroad for best practice sharing.
- Once a year a report will be published to share achievements and progress with the public.



Next Steps

- Granted the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole, the plan will take its course through the approval process.
- Make the plan official, and share with the public on the Aurora website.
- Continue to share City of Aurora progress in the quarterly Sustainable Aurora newsletter.
- Publish accomplishments in an annual report.
