NCIC Inmate Communications expects to generate considerably more calling revenue than the current Provider, based on the much lower, per-minute calling rates being proposed. Under the current rate structure, inmates (and their friends and families) are subject to an exorbitant 'First Minute' rate followed by additional per-minute rates which are excessive. By lowering the calling rates to only \$0.16/Minute (for *all* minutes of the call), overall call volume will increase as the users of the system realize that they're receiving much better "value for money." Additionally, NCIC is not proposing any of the exorbitantly priced "Single Payment" calls which are often peddled by other Providers in our industry, which only serve to confuse consumers and erode the commissionable calling revenue for the Agency.
