

Aurora Solar and EV Charging Rebate Program for Alderman-at-Large, John Laesch

Overview/Purpose:

The purpose of the Solar and EV Charging rebate program is to further incentivize Aurora residents to transition to fossil fuel free vehicles and solar energy. This is a pilot program that aims to capitalize on other existing programs and incentives through Citizens Utility Board's group buy solar program, state, and federal incentive programs, and COMED rebate programs. The alderman will work with residents and other entities to maximize incentives that help Aurora residents save on their energy bills and transition to a carbon-free future.

Type of Reimbursements:

The Alderman will appropriate up to \$15,000 of fiscal year 2024 aldermanic funds as incentives for Aurora residents for the following rebates:

- Up to \$1,000 reimbursement for installation of solar systems that utilize 5 or more panels.
- Up to \$500 reimbursement for the installation of a home EV charging system.
- Up to \$3,000 reimbursement for installation on multi-rooftop townhome projects or larger projects with 60 panels or more.


Qualifications:

- Applicants must be residents of the City of Aurora, IL., a business located in the corporate limits of Aurora, an HOA located in the corporate limits of Aurora, or a Non-profit (501c3) that operates and owns a building in the corporate limits of Aurora.
- This program is for residential, commercial, multi-use buildings, or free-standing systems.
- Applicants must obtain all necessary permits from the City of Aurora and pass post-installation inspections.
- Applicants in historic districts must also seek approval from the *Historic Preservation Commission* and comply with solar installation guidelines found in Section B.2.14.
- Applicants must present proof of purchase/installation before reimbursements are completed.
- Reimbursements are only available for people who purchase EV charging or solar systems. These incentives will not be available for people who rent or lease these systems, or for-profit entities charging a fee for charging service (example Tesla chargers).
- Reimbursements are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Applicants will be put on a waiting list when available funds in 2024 are exhausted.
- Applicant must be in good standing with the city, not owe any money, or have outstanding violations or liens against the property or entity.
- All systems must be installed by an electrician/contractor who is licensed in Illinois.
- Members of the Aurora City Council and their immediate family members are not eligible for this program.

Application Process:

All applications must be submitted to the Aldermen’s office and approved by Dec. 31,2024, for consideration. Reimbursements will be made after installation is completed and necessary receipts are submitted to the Aldermen’s Office (60 E. Downer Pl., Aurora, IL 60505).

STEP 2: Alderman Laesch through the Alderman’s Office will verify property ownership, verify that the property owner is in good standing and lien-free, and make sure that the property is a good candidate for a solar project based on sun exposure. We need to make sure the solar panels are not covered by trees. Property owners can pre-check their rooftop with COMED’s solar calculator - [MyGeneration - Landing\(comed.com\)](http://MyGeneration - Landing(comed.com))
