
Resolution 18-1016:

The primary purpose is to a *deliver fiber connection* on the south east side of Diehl Road at Eola Road for a secondary fiber exchange with Naperville (and DuPage County Traffic Management System (TMS)) for improved operations, redundancy and disaster recovery of *public safety services* and promote *economic development*.


- Provide Network Redundancy for Aurora and Naperville E911 dispatch, police and fire operations.
 - o On November 29, loss of network connectivity negatively impacted video conference capabilities for approximately 10 hours raising public safety and legal ramifications.
- Most Cost Effective & Practical Solution to deliver public safety services (out of 3 options).
 - 1. Low Cost & Low Complexity: Diehl-Eola to Naperville Water Tower (Indian Prairie Trail); Total Est. \$300k
 - Moderate Cost & Moderate Complexity: Aurora Fire Station 12 (Hafenrichter & Eola Roads) to Naperville (Normantown); Total Est. \$450k
 - 3. High Cost & High Complexity: Aurora Fire Station 8 (McCoy Dr) to Naperville Fire Station 10 (Rt. 59 & 95th); Total Est. >\$500k
- Expand infrastructure to promote economic development in I-88 Corridor at lower costs.
- Additional Benefits: include the ability to connect to the DuPage County Traffic Management System (TMS).
 - This location affords the opportunity to improve snow response and traffic management operations from DuPage County to Aurora citizens.
