SERVING AURORA RESIDENTS


- ✓ We serve over 5,000 Aurora residents each week
- ✓ Aurora residents are 50% of all the people we serve
- ✓ In fiscal year 2025, we served:
 - 242,000 Aurora residents (duplicated)
 - 18,700 Aurora residents (unique)
- ✓ Hub 2.0 will provide the capacity to serve 2x 3x more people


EXPANSION

- ✓ Purchased adjacent lot in 2023
- ✓ Adds approx. 32,000 sf
- √ \$8 million total investment

IMPACT

- ✓ 4x the cold storage space
- ✓ 3x the dry storage space
- ✓ 2x-3x the clients served









NOURISH TOGETHER

Dry and cold storage for other pantries at no charge.

Pantry collaborators include:

- ✓ Three signed mid-sized pantries serving northern and eastern DuPage County
- ✓ And several more in discussion



A COMMUNITY SOLUTION

SYSTEM-WIDE CAPACITY BUILDING

- ✓ Substantially Increases Healthy Food Accessibility
- ✓ Effective Use of Community Funds
 - Scales Capacity to Reach Unmet Need
 - Leverages Cost-Effective Model
- ✓ Enhances Pantry Collaboration
- ✓ Creates Greater Agility

REQUEST OF CITY OF AURORA

WAIVE MORATORIUM ON DATA CENTERS & WAREHOUSES

- ✓ Invested \$4.1 million already in the project
- ✓ Delays due to Moratorium result in:
 - Community economic hardship
 - Risk in project funding
 - Risk in project cost increase
