Aggregation Review



Suppliers: Eligo Energy

End Date: Last Program ended October 2022

Program Highlights

- Civic Contribution to Aurora \$356,654 per year.
- Program matched the ComEd Rate "No Rate Risk"
- Residents could leave the program at anytime with zero cancellation fees.
- Allowed Eligo to move customers back to ComEd as program became uneconomical.
- 100% Green Power for participants in the Aggregation Program.
 - Roughly 1/3 of residents in the program at start of program.
 - Less than 500 residents at the end of the program because Eligo sent them back to ComEd.
- EPA Green Partner Community Designation.

Civic Grant Program Results from RFP



Currently MC2 Energy is only Supplier offering Civic Grant Program with ComEd Price Match Guarantee.

- MC2 Energy Program does not offer any additional Green REC's
 - Price of Green REC's has increase 400% in past 24 months
- MC2 Energy Program no longer includes EPA Green Partner Program
 - EPA has changed the program requirements. Under previous EPA Program the Sponsoring Entity only had to purchase REC's for participants in the Aggregation Program. Under current rule EPA requires REC's to be purchased for all the power used by Sponsoring Entity.
