Sec. 14-5 Agreements with Other Political Subdivisions

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The coordinator may negotiate mutual aid agreements with other 1 2 units of local government, school districts, and cities or political subdivisions of the state on behalf of the city council 3 so long as any expenses associated with any such agreement are 4 5 properly payable from the department's existing budget and do not 6 create any additional liabilities for the city beyond those 7 ordinarily associated and contemplated by the operation of the 8 agency, but no such agreement shall be effective until it has been 9 reviewed by the corporation counsel and approved by the fire chief 10 in accordance with Sec. 2-283(d) of this code. Any agreement 11 entered under this section shall be cancellable on no more than 12 thirty (30) days' notice to the counterparty.
