



LIQUOR LICENSE OUTLINES



License #1: Main Casino

- 1A. Sportsbook (Sports Bar)
- 1B. O Bar (Main Bar)
- 1C. Red Lotus (Asian Restaurant)
- 1D. & Vine (Entertainment Bar)
- 1E. Casino Floor

License #2: VIP Lounge

License #3: Non-Gaming

- 3A. Ballrooms & Meeting Rooms
- 3B. Courtyard
- 3C. Spa
- 3D. Hotel Lobby & Tower
- 3E. Sorella by Giada

License #4: Social Hall

Liquor Licenses

- ❖ On-site: bars and restaurants**
- ❖ Specialty on-site: in-room mini-bar and room service**
- ❖ Package sales/on-site consumption: via convenience store**

Entertainment District Liquor License Endorsements

❖ *Casino Strolling Endorsement*

- ❖ Allows patrons to move between licensed premises with alcohol
- ❖ May not leave premises – including parking structure
- ❖ May utilize approved outdoor areas

Entertainment District Liquor License Endorsements

- ❖ ***Casino Barbershop, Salon or Spa Alcohol Service Endorsement***
 - ❖ **Similar to the existing Barbershop, Salon or Spa Alcohol Service License**
 - ❖ **Alcohol not sold by the glass but purchased in conjunction with a Spa Services Package**
 - ❖ **Two (2) drink maximum per day per person**

Allowed Hours of Operation and Alcohol Sales and Service

- ❖ **Sec 6-8 Allowable hours pursuant to the State of Illinois Liquor Control Act and the Illinois Gambling Act**
- ❖ ***Casino Hours. Per 230 ILCS 10/11(1.5) – An Owners licensee may conduct gambling operations authorized under this Act 24 hours a day.***
- ❖ ***Sale of Alcohol Per the Illinois Administrative Code:***
 - ❖ ***24/7 Gaming Operations = 9:30 a.m. – 4:00 a.m. each Gaming Day***
 - ❖ ***Not 24/7 Gaming Operations = 9:30 a.m. until one hour prior to the close of Gaming Operations***

Allowed Hours of Operation and Alcohol Sales and Service

- ❖ Allowed Hours for the Sale of Alcohol,
generally, depend on the specific license
classification when outside of the “Casino”
license. (See Exhibit A – p. 11)**
