TACTICAL RESPONSE TO DYNAMIC TERRORIST INCIDENTS

5 DAY HANDS-ON COURSE

Course Description:

This course is designed specifically for small specialized teams who are tasked with emergency response to critical incidents and implementation of counter measures against terrorist's attacks.

The course teaches proactive counter-terrorism tactics as they relate to the planning, preparation, and execution of hostage rescue, high risk building entry, vehicle takedowns/ assaults, bus assaults, "active shooter" incidents, dynamic and slow methodical operations in IED/ booby-trapped environments, high risk suspect detention and extraction in hostile environments, and other related missions.

Note: The material and skills taught in this course strictly adhere to all US constitutional laws as well as US law enforcement policies and regulations pertaining to use of force and standard methods of operation.

Training Objectives:

Upon completion, participants will:

- Possess an in-depth understand of the nature of dynamic terrorist incidents.
- ➤ Understand the roll of tactical operators in various counter terrorist operations.
- Understand the skills and tactics required to successfully handle a wide range of terrorist incidents.
- Possess the ability to formulate plans of action and utilize appropriate tactics based on overall risk assessment.
- Possess the ability to implement and articulate response tactics and level of force

Target Audience:

This course is designed for all levels of federal, state, and local law enforcement officers assigned to specialized enforcement, tactical units, or special units; officers assigned to protecting large venues and/ or critical infrastructure, as well as any individuals within such agencies who hold positions which influence decisions and policies. Such individuals may have direct influence over the standard of their agency's preparedness, planning of security measures for major events and/ or critical infrastructure, setting and implementing response protocols, development of counter-terrorism tactics, and designing standards of training for field application or specialized units.

Methods of Instruction:

This hands-on course combines classroom lectures utilizing PowerPoint presentations with hands-on practical exercises. It requires student involvement and direct participation in all stages of the training.

This course is **only** open to weapon carrying <u>full-time</u> commissioned Law Enforcement officers and/ or Government employees.

GENERAL COURSE OUTLINE

Note: Training consists of classroom session, hands-on drills, practical applications, and scenario based exercises.

- Fundamental skills and capabilities
 - Breaching
 - Firearms (long and short range capabilities)
 - Low light
 - High angle
 - Plain cloths operations
- Fundamental tactics
 - Room/ building clearing
 - Tubular assaults
 - Open field movement
 - Urban environment deployments
 - Vehicle and bus assaults
- Fundamentals of tactical risk assessment
- Considerations for using the proper deployment of resources and force continuum
- Practical exercises involving:
 - High risk search warrants
 - Barricaded subjects
 - Suicidal subjects
 - Hostage rescues
 - Active shooter
 - Combined methods of attack

Note: This full performance course requires a moderate degree of physical exertion, as well as basic manipulation and marksmanship skills with a handgun.

 - 2.4 Simulated position of cover (must be movable)
- 3. Live fire shoot house
- 4. Standard passenger bus

Note: <u>Simunitions</u> will be the <u>only</u> form of live fire exercises conducted on the bus

5. Vehicle suitable for simulation of vehicle assaults

Note: Based on the vehicle provided, the simulation may involve live fire or Simunition.

- 6. Simunition training area (outdoor or indoor) consisting of:
 - 6.1 180⁰ impact area for Simunition rounds (**NO LIVE AMMO**)
 - 6.2 Area must be able to accommodate approximately 30 mobile targets
 - 6.3 Approximately 30 mobile/ stable target stands
 - 6.4 Cardboard inserts for all target frames
- 7. Simunition weapons
 - 7.1 12 or more handguns
 - 7.2 12 or more shoulder mounted weapons
 - 7.3 2500 rounds of .556 FX marking rounds
 - 7.4 2500 rounds of 9mm FX marking rounds
- 8. 12 striking pads suitable for kicking and punching drills
- 9. Commercial or industrial building suitable for practical exercises

Note: <u>Simunitions</u> will be the <u>only</u> form of live fire exercises conducted at this location.

STUDENT EQUIPMENT LIST

Required equipment for each student attending the 5 day Hands-on Tactical Response to Dynamic Terrorist Incidents training:

- 1. Suitable dress for physical training
 - 1.1 BDU type pants are recommended. **NO sweatpants or shorts!**
 - 1.2 Footwear suitable for physical training.

NO dress shoes, sandals, or steel-toed footwear of any kind!

- 2. 2 Shirts: 1 sweatshirt or T-shirt and 1 button-down shirt, capable of concealing a firearm and related gear.
- 3. Personal Protection Equipment (PPE's)
 - 3.1 Eye protection (both clear and dark lenses are recommended)
 - 3.2 Ear protection
 - 3.3 Ballistic vest
 - 3.4 Ballistic helmet
- 4. Weapon systems:
 - 4.1 Duty weapon with at least 2 magazines
 - 4.2 Shoulder mounted weapon system with at least 3 magazines
- 5 Ammunition:
 - 5.1 300 Rounds of handgun ammo
 - 5.2 300 Rounds of rifle or SMG ammo (shoulder mounted weapon of choice)
- 6. Weapon related gear:
 - 6.1 Duty handgun holster
 - 6.2 Duty handgun magazine holders
 - 6.3 Concealed holster for undercover carry
 - 6.4 Concealed magazine holders
 - 6.5 Weapon mounted lights
 - 6.6 *Optional- IR laser and illuminator*
- 7. Restraining devices:
 - 7.1 1 set of handcuffs and keys
 - 7.2 Flex cuff type devices with suitable cutters

Optional recommended items:

- Water and drinking bottle
- Hats and sunscreen (weather conditions and training facilities dictating)
- Cold weather gear (weather conditions and training facilities dictating)
