Sealed bid proposals will be received at the office of the City Clerk, 44 E. Downer Place, First Floor, Aurora, IL 60507 until 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, May 17, 2023, to determine proposals for the abovenamed project per the specifications and terms and conditions contained herein. Proposals will be opened and read publicly via a non-mandatory teleconferenced and live streamed bid opening and also in person at 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, May 17, 2023, access details to be provided to all plan holders.

Attached please find specifications and other pertinent documents necessary for you to respond to this Invitation to Bid (Bid).

The proposed work consists of removing existing embedded shear connectors, repairing deteriorated concrete with high quality repair mortars on floors, double tee stems and flanges, beams, columns, walls, installing a new galvanized support angle, replacement of miscellaneous joint sealants, recoating isolated traffic toppings, cleaning existing drain lines and piping, and painting of perimeter railings.


