The grant applications will be ranked based upon project scope with the highest rated projects being recommended to the City Council by the Preservation Commission for approval. Following approval, a meeting with staff is required to review the project agreement and the grant process. Below is a list of additional items that may also be required as part of the review process:

- Historic Certificate of Appropriateness (HCOA) Application (required for all projects)
- **Building Permit Application**
- Scaled drawings of the proposed project
- Specifications and/or product information for materials to be used
- Material and/or color samples
- W-9 form upon approval of the grant

- Repairs needed: built in gutters
- soffits
- porch including fixing foundation, repairing support beams, restoration to original design
 rotting/animal damaged wood
 window frames

- painting exterior

Classic Gutters is pleased to submit our proposal for labor and material to complete the following:

Option 1.

Repair and replacement.

- 1. Front downspout coming out of upper flat roof, replace outlet and downspout with 4" round copper downspout.
- Front upper east right facing gutter that wraps around to the north side house.
 Prep surface and solder where needed. Apply rust proofing. Add additional 4" round copper downspout. Replace existing downspouts with 4" round copper downspouts.
- Two upper north side gutters. Prep surface and solder where needed. Apply rust proofing. Replace existing downspouts with 4" round galvanized downspouts.
- 4. Lower back porch. Replace entire pan with new yankee gutter in galvanized steel with rust proofing. Replace existing downspouts with 4" round copper downspouts. (To repair pitch problems).
- Upper north side and rear. Prep surface and solder where needed. Apply rust proofing.
 Replace existing downspouts with 4" round copper downspouts.
- 6. Upper south side rear. Replace entire pan with new yankee gutter in galvanized steel with rust proofing. Replace existing downspouts with 4" round copper downspouts. (To repair pitch problem).
- 7. Small gutter on south side below the turrets. Prep surface and solder where needed. Apply rust proofing. Replace outlet. Replace downspouts with 4" round copper downspout.
- 8. Two turrets. Replace pan in (v) sections (4) sections in total with a new yankee gutter and the balance of the turrets prep surface and solder where needed and rust proof. Add one additional downspout in 4" round copper and two additional outlets to drop on roof in galvanized. Replace existing downspout with 4" round copper downspout.

Total Cost: 14,212.26

Includes all material labor and lift rental.

Option 2.

Replace entire Yankee gutter system with a galvanized steel pan and all of the above existing and additional downspouts replace in 4" galvanized and 4" round copper with euro projection brackets. Also includes rust proofing.

Total cost: 20,360.00

Include all material labor and lift rental.

Option 3.

Front porch radius and left facing straight run of porch where there isn't a built in gutter.

Fabricate and install 6" k-style 20oz copper gutters hang with stainless threaded rods (to compensate for the pitch of the porch) with 4" round copper downspouts mounted with euro pipe bands. (install after paint and wood repair).

Total cost: 4,860.00

* **Note**: Any downspout that drops onto the lower roofs except for the additional one being added in front which will drop down into a copper gutter have to remain galvanized and can be painted to match. Otherwise the copper downspout water draining into metal will cause galvonic corrosion to the pan. All other downspouts that return to the ground will be copper.

Thank you for the opportunity to quote the following project.

Exterior Job description

This project includes preparation and painting to the following exterior surfaces:

- -Wood shingle siding
- -Wood fascia & eves
- -Bead board porch ceilings (front & back)
- -Painted wood doors, including front storm door, rear door and cellar doors
- -All wood windows, including basement windows and wood storm windows*
- *pricing based on number of storm windows present at time of estimate. Additional windows will require additional pricing
- -Dormers
- -Painted porch floors (front & back)
- -Porch posts
- -Exterior sides of stained front doors (to be refinished, not painted)
- -Front metal railings
- -Gutters & downspouts (to be painted to match adjacent surfaces)

All surfaces will be prepared and painted two (2) coats using premium Benjamin Moore paints. Colors and sheens TBD.

*Pricing includes a two-color scheme. Additional colors may require additional pricing

Loose paint will be scraped and bare wood will be primed prior to painting. Metal rails will be painted using a rust-inhibitive coating.

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Preparation

The following procedures will be applied as necessary to your particular job under normal conditions.

- All dirty and contaminated areas will be cleaned of dirt, salt deposits and mildew. Please note that windows may be spotted by this process and may need to be cleaned at the completion of the work by others at the owners' expense.
- All necessary areas will be protected with drop cloths, plastic, tape or other as needed.
- All gaps will be caulked with a 45 year sealant.
- Loose paint will be scraped.
- Bare wood will be primed.
- We will remove downspouts in order to paint behind them and reinstall them when finished.
- Upon completion, paint residue and debris will be cleaned up and taken away.
- Left over paint will be labeled and left at job site.

<u>Insurance</u>

- Precision Painting and Decorating Corp carries liability insurance and workmans compensation insurance.
- Certificates of insurance are available on request.

Limited Warranty

- Precision Painting and Decorating Corp warrants labor and material for a period of 5 years. If paint
 failure appears, we will supply labor and materials to correct the condition without cost. This warranty is in lieu of all
 other warranties, expressed or implied. Our responsibility is limited to correcting the condition as indicated above.
- This warranty excludes, and in no event will Precision Painting and Decorating Corp be responsible for consequential or incidental damages caused by accident or abuse, temperature changes, settlement or moisture; i.e. cracks caused by expansion and/or contraction. Cracks will be properly prepared as indicated at time of job, but will not be covered under this warranty.
- Decks and deck railings are excluded from all warranties, expressed or implied.

Work Standard

- Precision Painting and Decorating Corp is a member of the Painting and Decorating Contractors of America.
- All work is to be completed in a workman like manner according to standard practices. It is essential that the work area be available to us, free from other trades. Our employees will remain on the job until completion of the project, weather permitting. Work site will be cleaned daily and upon project completion. All agreements are contingent upon strikes, accidents, or delays beyond our control.
- Work procedures as per standards of the PDCA (Painting and Decorating Contractors of America). Copies of these standards are available on request.
- The painting contractor will produce a "properly prepared surface". A "properly prepared surface" is one that is uniform in color and sheen. It is one that is free of foreign material, lumps, skins, sags, holidays, misses, strike-through, or insufficient coverage. It is a surface that is free of drips, spatters, spills, or over spray which the contractor's workforce causes. Compliance to meeting the criteria of a "properly painted surface" shall be determined when viewed without magnification at a distance of five feet or more under normal lighting conditions and from a normal viewing position.

Change Orders

- If after you agree to this work, you desire any changes of additional work, please contact us as the cost of all revisions must be agreed upon in writing. Employees are instructed not to undertake additional work without authorization
- You will be notified of all needed carpentry work before it is done. Carpentry work is charged at a rate of \$60.00 per hour plus materials.



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Cost

- We propose to furnish labor and material- complete and in accordance with the above specifications for the sum of <u>all</u> as stated above. Individual tasks, if selected may require additional pricing. Price is valid for 90 days, unless otherwise noted.

Payment

- \$7,500.00 deposit is required to schedule the work proposed.
- Balance is due upon completion.
- Acceptable forms of payment are cash, check or credit card*
- *There will be a 3% fee for credit cards.
- Balances unpaid after 14 days of completion will be subject to finance charges in the amount of 18% annually.
