A Resolution authorizing the Director of Purchasing to execute a contract with Rubino Engineering in the amount of \$67,055.00 for materials testing at RiverEdge Park.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, There is an ongoing expansion of RiverEdge Park, which includes the construction of four new structures and expanded site hardscapes; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the materials for the various construction elements meet specifications, the City needs the services of a firm that specializes in material testing; and

WHEREAS, Rubino was asked to provide a proposal for these professional services, which do not require bidding; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of \$67,055.00 includes a \$10,000 contingency, the funds being available for CIP A062 in account 355-4440-451.73-43; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows: the Director of Purchasing is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Rubino Engineering in the amount of \$67,055.00 for materials testing at RiverEdge Park.

OR ANY OF ITS PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES BE FOUND TO HAVE BEEN NEGLIGENT IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS WORK, OR TO HAVE MADE AND BREACHED ANY EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY, REPRESENTATION OR CONTRACT. CLIENT, ALL PARTIES CLAIMING THROUGH CLIENT AND ALL PARTIES CLAIMING TO HAVE IN ANY WAY RELIED UPON RUBINO ENGINEERING, INC. 'S WORK, AGREE THAT THE MAXIMUM AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF THE LIABILITY OF RUBINO ENGINEERING, INC. ITS OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS SHALL BE LIMITED TO \$10,000.00 OR THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE FEE PAID TO RUBINO ENGINEERING, INC. FOR ITS WORK PERFORMED WITH RESPECT TO THE PROJECT, WHICHEVER AMOUNT IS GREATER
- NO ACTION OR CLAIM, WHETHER IN TORT, CONTRACT OR OTHERWISE, MAY BE BROUGHT AGAINST RUBINO ENGINEERING, INC. ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO RUBINO ENGINEERING INC.'S WORK, MORE THAN TWO (2) YEARS AFTER THE CESSATION OF RUBINO ENGINEERING, INC.'S WORK HEREUNDER
- 10. INDEMNITY: To the extent expressly authorized by state law. Client and Rubino Engineering, Inc. each agree to indemnify the other party and the other party is officers, directors, partners, employees, and representatives, from and against losses, damages, and judgments ansing from claims by third parties, including reasonable attorneys fees and expenses recoverable under applicable law, but only to the extent they are found to be caused by a negligent act, error, or omission of the indemnifying party is officers, directors, members, partners, agents, employees, subcontractors, or subconsultants in the performance of services under this Agreement. If claims, losses, damages, and judgments are found to be caused by the piont or concurrent negligence of Client and Rubino Engineering, Inc., they shall be borne by each party in proportion to its negligence. Neither by the insurance or indemnifications requirements of this Agreement does the City waive any privilege, defense, or immunity, which may be available to it, its elected officials, officers, or employees by law, including, but not limited to those set forth in the Local Governmental and Governmental Employees.
- 11. TERMINATION: This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon seven (7) days prior written notice. In the event of termination, Rubino Engineering, Inc. shall be compensated by Client for all services performed up to and including the termination date, including reimbursable expenses and for the completion of such services and records as are necessary to place Rubino Engineering, Inc.'s files in order and/or protect its professional reputation. Failure of Client to make payments when due shall be cause for suspension of services or, ultimately, termination, unless and until Rubino Engineering Inc. has been paid in full all amounts due for services, expenses and other related changes
- 12. DISPUTE RESOLUTION: In the event of a dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the services to be rendered hereunder, the Client and Rubino Engineering, Inc. agree to attempt to resolve such disputes in the following manner: 1) The parties agree to attempt to resolve any and all unsettled claims, counterclaims, disputes and other matters in question through direct negotiations between the appropriate representatives of each party; 2) If such negotiations are not fully successful, the parties agree to submit any and all remaining unsettled claims, counterclaims, disputes and other matters in question in accordance with the Construction Industry Mediation Rules of the American Arbitration Association, effective as of the date of this Agreement.
- 13. WITNESS FEES: Rubino Engineering, Inc.'s employees shall not be retained as expert witnesses except by separate written agreement
- 14. NO HIRE: (intentionally Left Blank
- 15. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: Nothing contained within this agreement shall be construed or interpreted as requiring Rubino Engineering. Inc. to assume the status of an owner, operator, storage, transporter, treater or disposal facility as those terms appear within RCRA, CERCLA, or within any Federat or State statute or regulation governing the generation, transportation, treatment, storage and disposal of pollutants. Clean assumes full responsibility for compliance with the provisions of RCRA, CERCLA and any other Federal or State statute or regulation governing the handling, treatment, storage and disposal of pollutants.
- 16. PROVISIONS SEVERABLE: The parties have entered into this agreement in good faith and it is the specific intent of the parties that the terms of the General Conditions be enforced as written. In the event any of the provisions of these General Conditions should be found to be unenforceable, it shall be stricken and the remaining provisions shall be enforceable.
- 17. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the parties, and there are no representations, warranties or undertakings made other than as set forth herein. This agreement may be amended, modified or terminated only in writing, signed by each of the parties hereto.
- 18. Illinois Freedom of Information Act. Rubino acknowledges the requirements of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and agrees to comply with all requests made by the City of Aurora for public records (as that term is defined by Section 2(c) of FOIA in the undersigned's possession and to provide the requested public records to the City of Aurora within two (2) business days of the request being made by the City of Aurora. The undersigned agrees to indemnity and hold harmless the City of Aurora from all claims, costs, penalty, losses and injuries (including but not limited to, attorney's fees, other professional fees, court costs and/or arbitration or other dispute resolution costs) ansing out of or relating to its feature to provide the public records to the City of Aurora under this agreement.

19. Jurisdiction and Venue. The Parties agree that in the event of fitigation arising from this Agreement, the exclusive venue for the adjudication of such disputes shall be the Circuit Court of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, Kane County and that the Ithnois law shall apply to such disputes without regard to its choice of law principles

20 . Insurance Requirements

Rubino, at its own expense, shall secure and maintain in effect throughout the duration of this contract, insurance of the following kinds and limits to cover all locations of the Rubino's operations.

Rubino shall furnish Certificates of Insurance to the City before starting or within ten (10) days after the execution of the contract, whichever date is reached first. All insurance policies shall be written with insurance companies approved by the City and licensed to do business in the State of Illinois and having a rating of not less than A IX, according to the latest edition of the A M. Best Company, and shall include a provision preventing cancellation of the insurance policy unless thirty (30) days prior written notice is given to the City.

This provision shall also be stated on each Certificate of Insurance as: "Should any of the above described policies be canceled before the expiration date thereof, the issuing company will endeavor to mail ten (10) days written notice to the certificate holder named to the left."

If requested, the awardee of this proposal will give the City a copy of the insurance policies. The policies must be delivered to the City within two weeks of the request.

The limits of liability for the insurance required shall provide coverage for not less than the following amount, or greater where required by law

- (1) Worker's Compensation Insurance Statutory amount
- (2) General Liability Insurance
 - (a) \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 general aggregate
 - (b) \$500,000 per occurrence for Property Damage
 - (c) \$1,000,000 per occurrence for Personal Injury
- (3) Auto Liability Insurance:
 - (a) Bodily Injury with limits not less than \$1,000,000
 - (b) Property damage with limits not less than \$500 000
- (4) Umbrella excess liability of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate

Rubino shall include the City as a primary non-contributory additional named insured on both General and Auto Liability Insurance policies and Indicate said status on any Certificates of Insurance provided to the City pursuant to this project. The Contractor shall pay all insurance premiums without cost to the City.
