
Amendment to Section 2-500



OVERVIEW OF THE PROPOSAL

- Action:** Amend Section 2-500 of the Aurora City Code.
- Change:** Increase the membership of the "Mayor's Sustainable Aurora Advisory Board" Advisory Board from **7 members to 9 members**.
- Goal:** To strengthen the city's capacity to implement sustainability plan and ensure a broader range of community expertise.

ADDRESSING OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES



Quorum Stability: With only seven members, the absence of just a few people can stall official business. Expanding to nine ensures that the board can consistently meet and vote on recommendations.



Workload Distribution: As the City Sustainability Plan grows, sub-committees require more "capacity."



Current Limit: The current code technically restricts the board's growth, even when highly qualified residents are eager to serve.

Comparison of Changes

| Feature | Current Code (7 Members) | Proposed Amendment (9 Members) |

| Board Size | 7 Members | 9 Members |
| Quorum Required | 4 Members | 5 Members |
| Expertise Range | Limited to 7 perspectives | Expanded to 9 perspectives |

- **Action Requested:** Approval of the ordinance amending Chapter 2, Section 2-500(b).
- **Recommendation:** Based on the need for increased diversity of expertise and operational efficiency, staff recommends the proposed resolution be adopted.


