Naperville	Fitness Facilities	4 parking spaces per each 1,000 square feet of gross floor area. The City may require that additional parking be provided if the facility includes competitions or special events; additional parking to be required will be determined based on the petitioner's submittal of a parking study for review and approval by the City. Any appeals to the City's final determination of total required parking shall be reviewed by the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Planning and Zoning Commission shall issue a final determination, unless appealed by the petitioner to City Council.	103

Naperville	Tennis Club/Tennis Court (contacted but no details to date)	1 space per 2000 sq ft of court area + 1 parking spaces per each 2 employees plus additional parking spaces, as applicable, for retail/services area	15
Shorewood	Tennis clubs / tennis court (contacted but no details to date)	1 parking space per each 2,000 square feet of court area, plus 1 parking space per each 2 employees, plus additional parking spaces, as applicable, for the retail/service area in accordance with the provisions of subsections D and E of this section.	15
