INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AURORA AND THE FOX VALLEY PARK DISTRICT CONCERNING A FIREWORKS SHOW AND OTHER PROGRAMMED ACTIVITIES ON PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY ON JULY 4, 2017/2019

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this _	day of	, 2017 by
and between the CITY OF AURORA, ILLINOIS, a	municipal corporation	("City") and
the FOX VALLEY PARK DISTRICT, an Illinois par	k district ("Park District	t'');

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Council of the City and the Board of Trustees of the Park District deem it expedient, advisable and in the best interests of the citizens of both governmental parties that the City contract with the Park District for the use of McCullough Park, and Veterans Island Park, and other trails areas interconnecting same during the July 4, 2017-2019 Independence Day festivities and fireworks shows and to set forth herein the salient terms of such agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the adequacy and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, it is hereby agreed as follows:

- 1. The City shall have non-exclusive use of McCullough Park each year on July 4, 2017-2019, with all activities programmed there to be conducted by the City.
- 2. The Prisco Center parking lot will be used as a handicapped parking and shuttle bus location by the City, but the Prisco Center will be closed and not accessible to the public each year on July 4, 2017-2019.
- 3. The Fox River Trail will remain open to the public with a partial closure south of Illinois Avenue, but only immediately prior to and during the fireworks show to be put on by or for the City from Veterans Island Park as described below. The City will coordinate and provide staffing for the closure and re-opening of the Fox River Trail
- 4. Veterans Island Park will be the launch site for the fireworks each year on July 4, 2017-2019 and each year on July 3, 2017-2019 the City and its contractors and agents shall have exclusive use of the boat ramp area and a portion of the grass area located on the site (the "launch site area") for purposes of setting up and launching the fireworks show. Each year on July 4, 2017-2019, the natural grass area located at Veterans Island Park may be used as the launch site area for the fireworks show, but any damage done to the grass area, as identified by the Parks District's natural area consultant will be repaired as soon as reasonably practicable by and at the expense of the City. The City is solely responsible for securing the

- launch site area at all times and for all activities related to or conducted thereon by the City or its contractors or agents.
- 5. On or before June 15, 2017-2019 each year, the City shall submit a list to the Park District of all proposed activities to be held on any of the Park District properties for approval by the staff of the Park District. The Park District will not unreasonably withhold consent to proposed activities, but may withhold consent regarding specific activities if it reasonably determines that such activities may create exposure to a liability which the District believes is unreasonable under the circumstances.
- 6. The City and any vendors which they propose using shall submit a Certificate of Insurance meeting all Park District requirements no later than thirty (30) days prior to the event. See Exhibit A for requirements.
- 7. The City shall be responsible for all setup and adequate staffing for the events and programmed activities, including sufficient security to maintain order on all Park District properties.
- 8. All litter accumulated on Park District property shall be cleaned up by the City and Park District jointly within 24 hours of the completion of the final events each year on July 4, 2017-2019.
- 9. The City shall be responsible for any and all damage done to Park District property as a result of the July 4, 2017-2019 programmed activities and fireworks show. Any damage that occurs shall be repaired by the City within 30 days. Further, the City agrees to indemnify and hold the Park District harmless from and against any claims for liability arising out of the City's use of the Park District property for the programmed events, including the fireworks show.
- 10. Park District employees and officers are not, and shall not be considered employees of the City, and shall at all times be and remain employees and officers of the Park District for purposes of this Agreement. The Park District shall continue to have police authority for its Park properties, notwithstanding the non-exclusive use by the City hereunder, but the City of Aurora shall have co-extensive jurisdiction for its police at the Park properties for each year's July 4, 2017-2019 events to enforce all Park District ordinances, including its General Use Ordinance, as well as all other applicable laws and statutes.
- 11. No change, modification or amendment to this Agreement shall be valid unless reduced to writing, approved by the Council or Board of both the City and the Park District, and executed by the parties' respective officers.
