CITY OF AURORA, ILLINOIS ORDINANCE NO. DATE OF PASSAGE

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG IL ROUTE 59 WITHIN THE CITY OF AURORA

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety. morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois acting by and through its Department of Transportation is desirous of improving. Il Route 50 from approximately 550 feet north of North A

feet south of Aurora Avenue/New York Street known as FAP Route 338, State Section (112 & 113) WRS-7, in the CITY OF AURORA; and
WHEREAS, a portion of this project runs through the City of Aurora, and
WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and ensure safety to the motoring public, the City has determined that parking along IL Route 59 shall be prohibited, as provided in the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Aurora and the State of Illinois/Department of Transportation dated
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Counties of Kane, DuPage, Will and Kendall, in the State of Illinois, as follows:
Section One: That parking shall not be permitted along IL Route 59 from approximately 1600 feet south of North Aurora Road to 800 feet south of Aurora Avenue/New York Street known as FAP Route 338, State Section (112 & 113) WRS-7, within the City limits of the City of Aurora pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Aurora and the State of Illinois/Department of Transportation dated
Section Two: That the City Council of the City of Aurora will prohibit future parking at such locations within said IL Route 59 Right of Way as may be determined and directed by the State of Illinois to be necessary to ensure the free flow of traffic and safety to the motoring public.
Section Three: That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attach a copy of this Ordinance to the Agreement dated, 20 by and between the State of Illinois and

the City of Aurora.

Section Four: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and shall be controlling immediately upon passage and approval.

Section Five: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

Section Six: That any Section or provision of this Ordinance that is construed to be invalid or void shall not affect the remaining sections or provisions which shall remain in full force and effect thereafter.
