## **Sec 6-2 Definitions**

 Full-service restaurant means a restaurant that offers a full complement of menu items prepared onsite and served to patrons via table service, generally, for consumption on-site. The primary focus of a full-service restaurant is the service of meals. Restaurants in the nature of fast-food, fast-casual or drive-through restaurants are not considered full-service restaurants. A full-service restaurant shall have a minimum seating capacity of one hundred twenty-five (125) seats on the same floor. A full-service restaurant is the only publicly accessible category where video gaming may be permitted. This license shall only be available for premises defined as a restaurant herein that has a minimum seating capacity of one hundred twenty-five (125) seats on the same floor or level, or in a shopping center, as defined herein, a new license shall also be available for premises defined as restaurants herein that have a minimum seating capacity of seventy-five (75) seats. To be eligible for video gaming, establishments must also meet all requirements of Chapter 8, Article IV, Division 5 entitled "Video Gaming".
