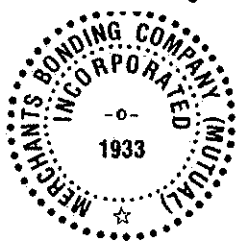

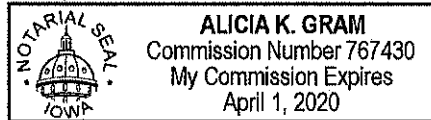

The undersigned agrees that if the City decides to alter the improvement by extras or deductions, including the elimination of any one or more of the items, as provided in the specifications, he will perform the work as altered, increased or decreased, at the contract unit prices without claim for profits lost as a result of any work or items eliminated by the City of Aurora.

Some quantities in the Schedule of Prices are estimated, so the selected contractor will be paid according to the quantities measured during the demolition.
