RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO STEWART SPREADING, INC.  
FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF LIME SLUDGE  
FOR THE WATER PRODUCTION DIVISION

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (1) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Water Production Division generates a lime sludge waste product from the water treatment process which must be removed and disposed either via landfilling or via land application by an outside contractor whose current contract is due to expire on October 22, 2012; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and publicly opened and read separately on August 15, 2012, for both landfilling and land application of the lime sludge; and



WHEREAS, Stewart Spreading, Inc., Sheridan, IL has been determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder for both ultimate disposal methods in the estimated annual amounts of \$852,500.00 for landfilling and \$347,500.00 for land application; and




WHEREAS, the agreement shall be for a two-year minimum term with options to extend based upon mutual agreement between the contractor and the City of Aurora; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the 2012 City Budget in Account No. 510-1851-511-36-25 and are expected to be available in future budgets for lime sludge removal and disposal;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, does hereby authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a contract with Stewart Spreading, Inc. in the estimated annual amounts of \$852,500.00 for landfilling and \$347,500.00 for land application for lime sludge removal and disposal for the Water Production Division.
