Scope of Services

Provider hereby agrees to furnish the following services: (1) Post-Offer/Pre-Employment Screening; (2) Fitness for Duty Evaluation; and (3) Critical Incident Debriefing (See Appendix A).

Payments

In consideration of the services described above, the Commission/Agency hereby agrees to pay to Provider upon receipt of approved invoice, at the following rates:

Post-Offer/Pre-Employment Screening - \$625 per applicant, utilizing the Matrix Psychological Uniform Law Enforcement Selection Evaluation (M-Pulse © /M-Flame ©) methodology as described in Appendix A.

Fitness for Duty Evaluation (on an as-needed basis) – \$750 per diagnostic interview; psychological testing, \$1,875; report construction, file reviews, and consultations, \$375/hour.

Critical Incident Debriefing or Other Professional Consultation - \$475/hour (on an as-needed basis).

Payment is due within 30 days of receipt of invoice.

Termination

The Commission/Agency and/or the Provider may terminate this Contract by providing the other party 30 days written notice.

Ownership

All records, reports, documents and other material delivered or transmitted to Provider by Commission/Agency shall remain the property of Commission/Agency, and shall be returned by Provider to Commission/Agency, at Provider's expense, at termination or expiration of this agreement. All records, reports, documents or other material related to this Contract and/or obtained or prepared by Provider in connection with the performance of the services contracted for herein shall become the property of Commission/Agency, and shall, upon request, be returned by Provider to Commission/Agency, at Provider's expense, at termination or expiration of this agreement.

Taxes

Provider hereby agrees that he is responsible for payment of taxes/fees due from the funds thus received under this agreement.

Assignment

The Provider shall not assign any interest in this agreement and shall not transfer any interest in same without prior written consent of the Commission/Agency, provided however, that claims for money due or to become due to the Provider from the Commission/Agency may be assigned to a bank, trust company, or other financial institution without such prior written consent. Notice of any such assignment or transfer shall be furnished promptly to the Commission/Agency.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Provider hereby agrees to furnish the following services utilizing the MATRIX-Psychological Uniform Law Enforcement Selection Evaluation (M-PULSE) and/or MATRIX-Firefighter Liability and Management Evaluation Inventory (M-FLAME):

Post-Offer/Pre-Employment psychological screening of police and/or firefighter/paramedic and/or dispatch/telecommunicator candidates to determine suitability for employment as a police officer or firefighter/paramedic with the Commission/Agency.

Post-offer/Pre-Employment screening shall result in: (A) suitable for employment as a police officer and/or firefighter/paramedic and/or dispatch/telecommunicator; (B) not suitable for employment as a police officer and/or firefighter/paramedic and/or dispatch/telecommunicator; or (C) suitable for employment as a police officer and/or firefighter/paramedic and/or dispatch/telecommunicator with training recommendations.
