

Each year, the Sustainable Aurora Advisory Board attempts to influence positive changes in the city government and our citizens. In 2016, the board created an updated sustainability plan. It's time to make it official.



History

- The City of Aurora approved its first Sustainability Plan in 2009.
- A Sustainable Aurora Advisory Board was created in 2014.
- The first task the board decided to undertake was to create an updated sustainability plan to address ongoing issues, concerns and opportunities.







Major Changes in the Plan

- Simplified the plan while adding sections missing in the original plan
- Three additional focus areas were added: Climate, Resilient Community, and Environmental Justice
- The plan moved from being task oriented to strategic
- Greater interconnection to Chicago Metropolitan Region while maintaining a clear Aurora perspective



Framework

- The sustainability plan update of 2016, was restructure using the Greenest Region Compact 2 from the Metropolitan Mayor's Caucus as a template.
- The Board also shifted from a task oriented perspective in the first plan to a more strategic focus.
- The updated plan is easier to understand and track over time.
