That part of Marywood Acres Unit 5, a subdivision of part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 38 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 127 of said Marywood Acres Unit 5; thence Northerly on a 3° 01' degree curve to the left along the Easterly line of said Lot 127 and of Lot 126 of said Marywood Acres Unit 5 to the Northeast corner of said Lot 126; thence Easterly along the North line of said Lot 126 extended Easterly for 67.8 feet; thence Southerly on a 2° 55' degree curve to the right, parallel with said Easterly line of Lots 126 and 127 for 473.15 feet to a point on the Easterly extension of the South line of said Lot 127 lying 66 feet Easterly from the Southeast corner of said Lot 127; thence Westerly along said Easterly extension for 66 feet to the point of beginning, in the Township of Aurora, Kane County, Illinois;
